persuasion Most studies to date have focused on either the psychological principles involved in watching and performing magic or neuromagic the neural correlates of such phenomena Whereas performers sometimes question the contributions that modern science may offer to the advancement of the magical arts the history of magic reveals that scientific discovery often charts new territories for magicians In this research topic we sketch out the symbiotic relationship between psychological science and the art of magic On the one hand magic can inform psychology with particular benefits for into existing experimental even clinical paradigms paves the road to innovative trajectories in the study of human behaviour For example magic provides an elegant way to study the behaviour of
