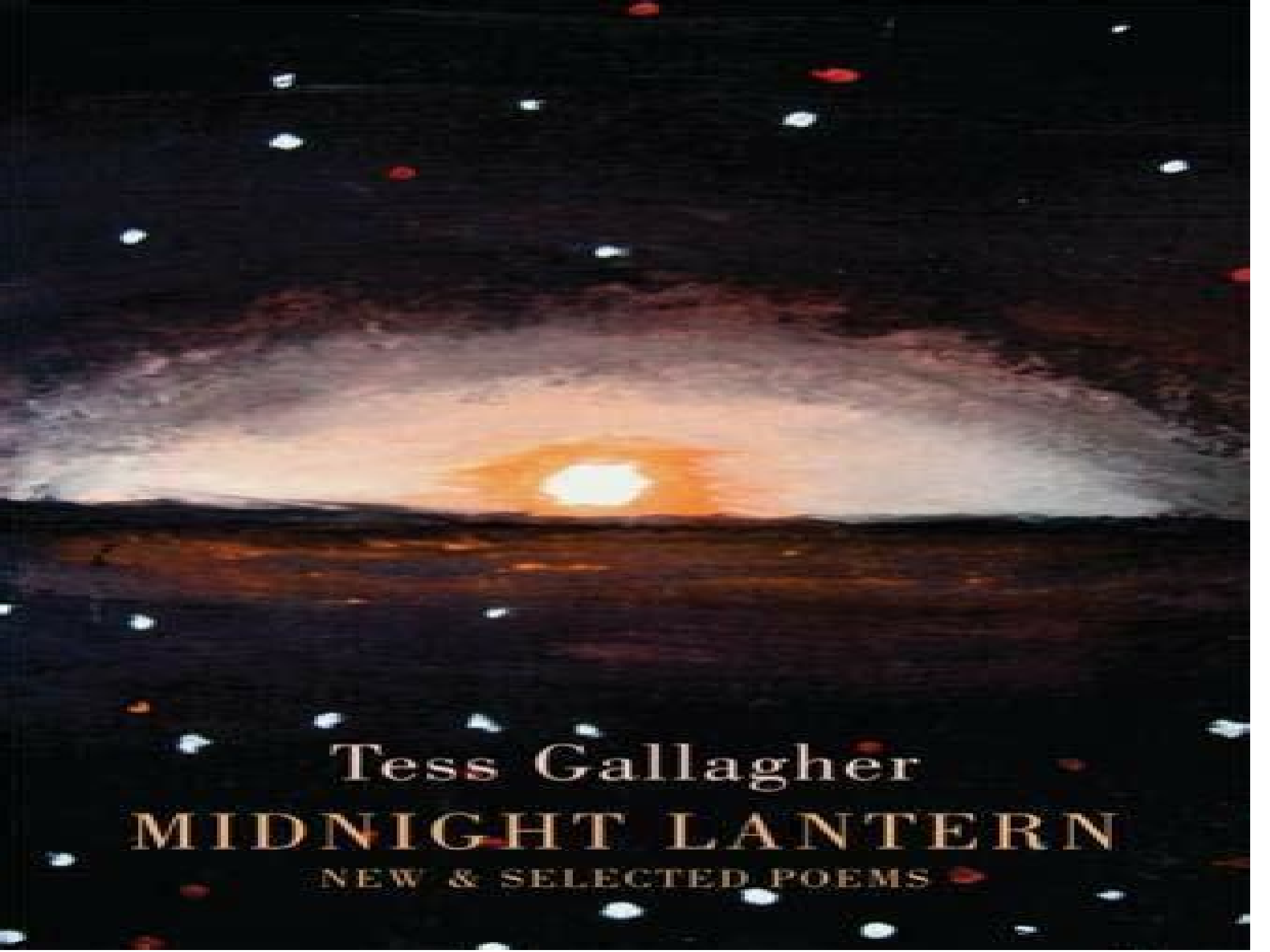

The Collected Poems of Robert Penn Warren Robert Penn Warren, 1998-10-01 Winner of the C Hugh Holman Award A central figure in

twentieth century American literature Robert Penn Warren 1905 1989 was appointed by the Library of Congress as the first Poet Laureate of the United States in 1985 Although better known for his fiction especially his novel *All the King's Men* it is mainly his poetry spanning sixty years fifteen volumes of verse and a wide range of styles that reveals Warren to be one of America's foremost men of letters In this indispensable volume John Burt Warren's literary executor has assembled every poem Warren ever published with the exception of *Brother to Dragons* including the many poems he published in *The Fugitive* and other magazines as well as those that appeared in his small press works and broadsides Burt has also exhaustively collated all of the published versions of Warren's poems which in some cases appeared as many as six different times with substantive revisions in every line as well as his typescripts and proofs And since Warren never seemed to reread any of his books without a pencil in his hand Burt has referred to Warren's personal library copies This comprehensive edition also contains textual notes lists of emendations and explanatory notes Warren was born and raised in Guthrie Kentucky where southern agrarian values and a predilection for storytelling were ingrained in him as a young boy By 1925 when he graduated from Vanderbilt University he was already the most promising of that exceptional set of poets and intellectuals known as the Fugitives Warren devoted most of the 1940s and 1950s to writing prose and literary criticism but from the late 1950s he composed primarily poetry with each successive volume of verse that he penned demonstrating his rigorous and growing commitment to that genre The mature visionary power and technical virtuosity of his work in the 1970s and early 1980s emanated from his strongly held belief that only insofar as the work of art establishes and expresses a self can it engage us Many of Warren's later poems which he deemed some of my best rejoice in the possibilities of old age and the poet's ability for continually expanding in a vital process of definition affirmation revision and growth a process that is the image we may say of the life process

Molotov's Magic Lantern Rachel Polonsky, 2010-03-18 When Rachel Polonsky went to live in Moscow she found an apartment block in Romanov Street once a residence of the Soviet elite One of those ghostly neighbours was Stalin's henchman Vyacheslav Molotov In Molotov's former apartment Rachel Polonsky discovered his library and an old magic lantern Molotov, ruthless apparatchik, participant in the collectivizations and the Great Purge, was also an ardent bibliophile Molotov's library and his magic lantern became the prisms through which Rachel Polonsky renewed her vision of Russia She visited cities and landscapes associated with the books in the library: Chekhov, Dostoevsky, Pushkin, Akhmatova and many less well-known figures Some were sent to the Gulag by the man who collected their books She writes exceptionally well about the longings and aspirations of Russian writers in the course of a journey that takes her to the Arctic and Siberia, the Crimean summer and Lake Baikal, from the forests around Moscow to the vast steppes In each place she encountered the spirit of great artists and the terrible past of a country ravaged by war, famine and totalitarianism

Island of Daemons Terence Dewsnap, 2008 *Island of Daemons* interprets accounts of the Donegal pilgrimage including histories, guidebooks, devotional writing, newspaper and magazine articles as well as three major poems by twentieth-century Irish poets The pilgrimage history documents religious and political themes as well as the experience of pilgrimage as arduous, enlightening and humbling Early writings often stressed the sensational, with miracles, devils and hideous torture Most Lough Derg writings have been devotional but there is a strong tradition of satire as well Skepticism competes with reverence It is important to locate each modern poet within a tradition of choices made in times past This study, attempting to register the variety of attitudes associated with Lough Derg, depends at times on hypothesis, speculative possibilities rather than definite sources or influences This study will be useful to Irish Studies students, teachers of Irish literature and history as well as those interested in cultural studies and religion
