


Here we presented the concept that instruction should be provided to learners that is equivalent rather than identical to what might be delivered in a traditional environment Equivalency theory helps the instructional designer approach the development of instruction for each learner without attempting to duplicate what happens in a face to face classroom. The final theme for Teaching and Learning at a Distance is the idea that the book should be comprehensive that it should cover as much of the various ways instruction is made available to distant learners as is possible It should be a single source of information about the field
