older ideas about responsible breadwinning fatherhood in their discourse about being good fathers while on the road. This discourse is in some conflict with the lived experiences of Christian truckers who simultaneously find themselves confronted by more contemporary cultural narratives of the work-family balance and expectations of what it means to be a good worker or a good trucker.
