Materializing the Middle Passage Jane Webster, 2023-10-31 An estimated 2.7 million Africans made an enforced crossing of the Atlantic on British slave ships between c 1680 and 1807 a journey that has become known as the Middle Passage This book focuses on the slave ship itself The slave ship is the largest artefact of the Transatlantic slave trade but because so few examples of wrecked slaving vessels have been located at sea it is rarely studied by archaeologists Materializing the Middle Passage A Historical Archaeology of British Slave Shipping 1680 1807 argues that there are other ways for archaeologists to materialize the slave ship It employs a pioneering interdisciplinary methodology combining primary documentary sources maritime and terrestrial archaeology paintings maritime and ethnographic museum collections and many other sources to rebuild British slaving vessels and to identify changes to them over time The book then goes on to consider the reception of the slave ship and its trade goods in coastal West Africa and details the range and uses of the many African resources including ivory gold and live animals

entering Britain on returning slave ships The third section of the book focuses on the Middle Passage experiences of both captives and crews and argues that greater attention needs to be paid to the coping mechanisms through which Africans survived yet also challenged their captive passage Finally Jane Webster asks why the African Middle Passage experience remains so elusive even after decades of scholarship dedicated to uncovering it She considers when how and why the crossing was remembered by saltwater captives in the Caribbean and North America The marriage of words and things attempted in this richly illustrated book is underpinned throughout by a theoretical perspective combining creolization and postcolonial theory and by a central focus on the materiality of the slave ship and its regimes **Surviving the Middle**

The Northernmost Ruins of the Globe Bjarne Grønnow, Jens Fog Jensen, 2003-10-15 An important part of the heritage of Count Eigil Knuth 1903 1996 is his archaeological archive containing contextual information on prehistoric sites gathered during six decades of research in High Arctic Greenland The finds and observations are a key to the understanding of human life under extreme conditions in a long term perspective and represent a unique piece of evidence concerning the early cultural history of the Eastern Arctic Knuth's expeditions from 1932 to 1995 took him to Greenland and Canada in particular High Arctic Greenland In a number of important articles Knuth published the findings dating back to the earliest human settlement in Greenland However he never managed to present the complete body of information and results from his many investigations The present authors have thus compiled a computer database on the basis on his archive which constitutes the starting point of the present book The book focuses on Knuth's most substantial contribution to archaeology the prehistory of Peary Land and adjacent areas In the catalog emphasis has been placed on topographical and architectural information site structure artefact statistics and radiocarbon dates A total of 154 archaeological sites are presented Fifty one sites with a total of 244 features are Independence I sites c 2460 1860 cal BC twenty three sites with a total of 416 features belong to Independence II c 900 400 cal BC and sixty three sites with a total of 626 features are of Thule origin c 1400 1500 ca AD This study presents some new information on the faunal material from Peary Land based on Christyann Darwent's recent analyses as well as new data on the dwelling features on the Adam C Knuth Site which was visited by a multidisciplinary team in 2001 It also offers an introduction presenting an overview and evaluation of Knuth's remarkable curriculum vitae as an independent arctic archaeologist In the concluding chapters some basic statistics on the archaeological sites are presented We evaluate Knuth's radiocarbon datings of the Independence I Independence II and Thule cultures in High Arctic Greenland and settlement distributions and settlement patterns for the three cultures represented in Peary Land are discussed
