Swain,2006-06-01 Born raised and retired in Mississippi Lucy Somerville Howorth 1895 1997 was a champion for the rights of women long before feminism emerged as a widely recognized movement As told by Dorothy S Shawhan and Martha H Swain hers is a remarkable life story from a small town upbringing to a career as an attorney an activist and the last of a generation of New Deal women in Washington D C She held a presidential appointment under every chief executive from Franklin Roosevelt to John Kennedy Howorth was a fervent believer in the power of organizations to bring about change and she became known for her leadership qualities acumen and quick appraisal of social problems particularly as they affected women Shawhan and Swain point out that her winsome personality small stature and delightful sense of humor also aided her as a female aspiring in a man s world In 1931 she was elected to the Mississippi House of Representatives and after campaigning for Roosevelt was rewarded by the new president with a federal appointment She served in a number of subsequent roles rising to become
