One Crowded Hour Tim Bowden, 2013-08-01 *One Crowded Hour* is the bestselling biography of one of the world's greatest combat cinematographers and an extraordinary Australian. Facing Death in Cambodia Peter Maguire, 2005-03-30 The Khmer Rouge regime took control of Cambodia by force of arms, then committed the most brazen crimes since the Third Reich: at least 1.5 million people murdered between 1975 and 1979. Yet no individuals were ever tried or punished. This book is the story of Peter Maguire's effort to learn how Cambodia's culture of impunity developed, why it persists, and the failures of the international community to confront the Cambodian genocide. Written from a personal and historical perspective, *Facing Death in Cambodia* recounts Maguire's growing anguish over the gap between theories of universal justice and political realities. Maguire documents the atrocities and the aftermath through personal interviews with victims and perpetrators, discussions with international and NGO officials, journalistic accounts, and government sources gathered during a ten-year odyssey in search of answers. The book includes a selection of haunting pictures from among the thousands taken at the now infamous Tuol Sleng prison, also referred to as S-21, through which at least 14,000 men, women, and children passed, and from which fewer than a dozen emerged alive. What he discovered raises troubling questions: Was the Cambodian genocide a preview of the genocidal civil wars that would follow in the wake of the Cold War? Is international justice an attainable idea or a fiction superimposed over an unbearably dark reality? Did issues of political expediency allow Cambodian leaders to escape prosecution? The Khmer Rouge violated the Nuremberg Principles, the United Nations Charter, the laws of war, and the UN Genocide Convention. Yet in the decade after the regime's collapse, the perpetrators were rescued and rehabilitated, even rewarded by China, Thailand, the United States, and the UN. According to Peter Maguire, Cambodia holds the key to understanding why recent UN interventions throughout the world have failed to prevent atrocities and to enforce treaties.

Hidden Horrors Yuki Tanaka, 2017-10-06 This landmark book documents little-known wartime Japanese atrocities during World War II. Yuki Tanaka's case studies are still remarkably original and significant, including cannibalism, the slaughter and starvation of prisoners of war, the rape, enforced prostitution, and murder of

noncombatants and biological warfare experiments The author describes how desperate Japanese soldiers consumed the flesh of their own comrades killed in fighting as well as that of Australians Pakistanis and Indians He traces the fate of sixty five shipwrecked Australian nurses and British soldiers who were shot or stabbed to death by their captors Another thirty two nurses were captured and sent to Sumatra to become comfort women sex slaves for Japanese soldiers Tanaka recounts how thousands of Australian and British POWs were massacred in the infamous Sandakan camp in the Borneo jungle in 1945 while those who survived were forced to endure a tortuous 160 mile march on which anyone who dropped out of line was immediately shot This new edition also includes a powerful chapter on the island of Nauru where thirty nine leprosy patients were killed and thousands of Naurans were ill treated and forced to leave their homes Without denying individual and national responsibility the author explores individual atrocities in their broader social psychological and institutional milieu and places Japanese behavior during the war in the broader context of the dehumanization of men at war In his substantially revised conclusion Tanaka brings in significant new interpretations to explain why Japanese imperial forces were so brutal tracing the historical processes that created such a unique military structure and ideology Finally he investigates why a strong awareness of their collective responsibility for wartime atrocities has been and still is lacking among the Japanese

It has been home to Iberian missionaries and French colonialists with a stunning mix of traditional palaces, Buddhist temples and transplanted French architecture. In the 1960s Phnom Penh deserved its reputation as the most attractive city in Southeast Asia. But after 1970 all this was to change and a terrible civil war was followed by the Khmer Rouge's capture of the city in 1975. Since the defeat of Pol Pot in 1979 Phnom Penh has slowly recovered once again attracting perceptive travellers.

The Tragedy of Cambodian History
David Porter Chandler, 1991-01-01 The political history of Cambodia between 1945 and 1979 which culminated in the devastating revolutionary excesses of the Pol Pot regime is one of unrest and misery. This book by David P. Chandler is the first to give a full account of this tumultuous period. Drawing on his experience as a foreign service officer in Phnom Penh on interviews and on archival material, Chandler considers why the revolution happened and how it was related to Cambodia's earlier history and to other events in Southeast Asia. He describes Cambodia's brief spell of independence from Japan after the end of World War II, the long and complicated rule of Norodom Sihanouk during which the Vietnam War gradually spilled over Cambodia's borders, the bloodless coup of 1970 that deposed Sihanouk and put in power the feeble pro-American government of Lon Nol, and the revolution in 1975 that ushered in the radical changes and horrors of Pol Pot's Communist regime. Chandler discusses how Pol Pot and his colleagues evacuated Cambodia's cities and towns, transformed its seven million people into an unpaid labor force, tortured and killed party members when agricultural quotas were unmet, and were finally overthrown in the course of a Vietnamese military invasion in 1979. His book is a penetrating and poignant analysis of this fierce revolutionary period and the events of the previous quarter century that made it possible.
