The book introduces the concept of entrepreneurial citizens: those who utilize their innovative skills and behaviors to claim both economic and social rights from which they had been previously excluded. The programs taught youth how to develop their own enterprises to earn profits and to save for their own futures, but youth used their education skills and labor to provide for basic needs, to be included in society, and to support their and their families' well-being. By showing the contradictory effects of entrepreneurship education programs, the book asks international agencies and governments to consider how they can go beyond technical approaches of creating enterprises and increasing income and head toward approaches that consider the kinds of labor that young people and communities value for their well-being.
