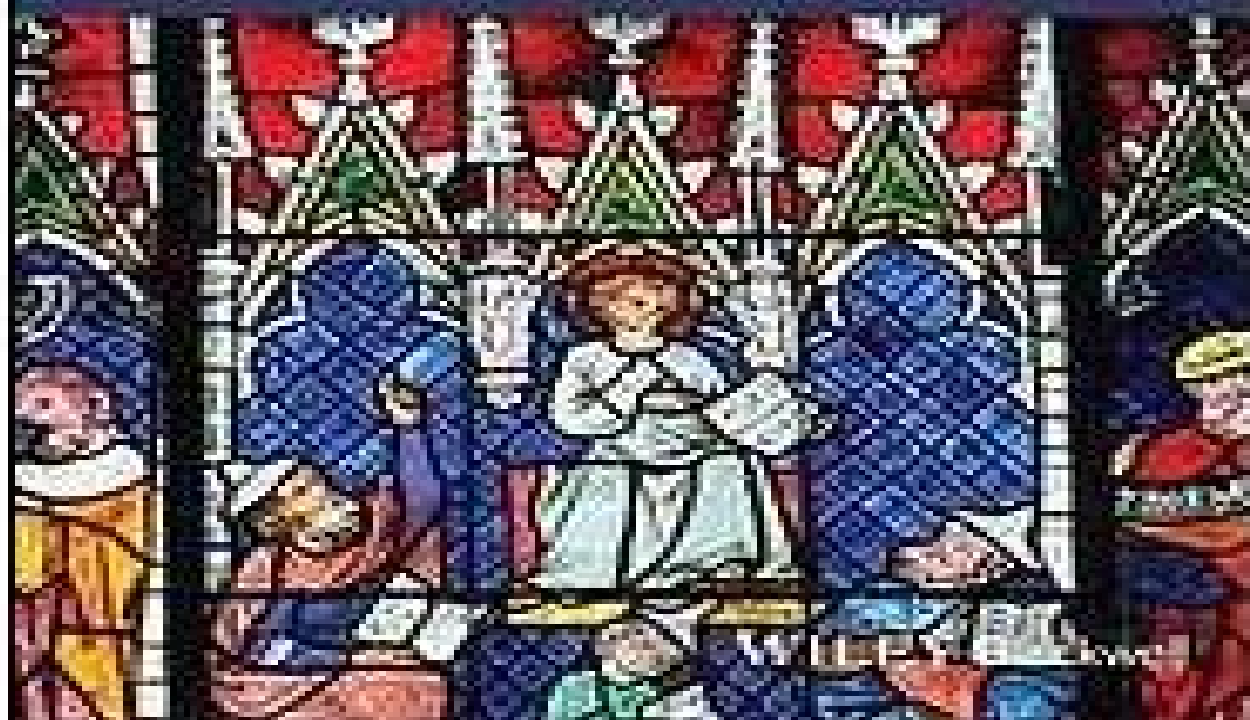

The name itself refers to the time between the high philosophical and literary accomplishments of the Greco Roman world and the technological advances that were achieved and philosophical and theological alternatives that were formulated in the modern world that followed. However, having produced such great philosophers as Anselm, Peter Abelard, John Duns Scotus, William of Ockham, Peter Lombard and the towering Thomas Aquinas, it hardly seems fair to label the medieval period as such.
