adapt to their dislocation by finding the best substitutes for a sustaining social and spiritual life that they can and addiction serves this function all too well The book argues that the most effective response to a growing addiction problem is a social and political one rather than an individual one Such a solution would not put the doctors psychologists social workers policemen and priests out of work but it would incorporate their practices in a larger social project The project is to reshape society with enough force and imagination to enable people to find social integration and meaning in everyday life Then great numbers of them would not need to fill their inner void with addictions
