Médecins Sans Frontières, Evolution of an International Movement: Associative History 1971-2011 Laurence Binet, Martin Saulnier, 2019-06-04 When Médecins Sans Frontières MSF was founded in 1971 it was founded with both international and associative dimensions International because it wouldn't have made sense for MSF France on its own to aid threatened populations around the world and associative because civil law in France especially the 1901 law governing charitable bodies was perfectly suited to the MSF organisation's guiding precepts which are democratic and selfless in nature Yet MSF's development from a small purely French organisation to an international associative movement was never carefully planned or particularly smooth MSF's development was the result of various compromises between the movement's leaders with their individual agendas and the integration of *fait accompli* when necessary The evolving modifications were debated at length to ensure that concerns raised were legitimate and that there was agreement for decisions made The nature and the validity of MSF's leadership were regularly challenged as was the question of how MSF should grow while remaining true to its humanitarian precepts This case study elaborates the history of the MSF movement from inception in 1971 through 2011 when MSF legitimised an international governance system and architecture The study is divided in two episodes Episode One reviews MSF's first three decades 1971-2000 Episode Two is about the challenges of the early 21st century from 2001 to 2011

Idealism beyond Borders Eleanor Davey, 2015-12-17 This is a major new account of how modern humanitarian action was shaped by transformations in the French intellectual and political landscape from the 1950s to the 1980s Eleanor Davey reveals how radical left third worldism was displaced by the sans frontières movement as the dominant way of approaching suffering in what was then called the third world Third worldism regarded these regions as the motor for international revolution but revolutionary zeal disintegrated as a number of its regimes took on violent and dictatorial forms Instead the radical humanitarianism of the sans frontières movement pioneered by Médecins Sans Frontières emerged as an alternative model for international aid Covering a period of major international upheavals and domestic change in France Davey demonstrates the importance of memories of

the Second World War in political activism and humanitarian action and underlines the powerful legacies of Cold War politics for international affairs since the fall of the Iron Curtain

The Politics of Humanitarian Technology Katja Lindskov Jacobsen, 2015-06-05 This book offers a detailed exploration of three examples of humanitarian uses of new technology employing key theoretical insights from Foucault We are currently seeing a humanitarian turn to new digital technologies such as biometrics remote sensing and surveillance drones However such humanitarian uses of new technology have not always produced beneficial results for those at the receiving end and have sometimes exposed the subjects of assistance to additional risks and insecurities Engaging with key insights from the work of Foucault combined with selected concepts from the Science and Technology Studies literature this book produces an analytical framework that opens up the analysis to details of power and control at the level of materiality that are often ignored in liberal histories of war and modernity Whereas Foucault details the design of prisons factories schools etc this book is original in its use of his work in that it uses these key insights about the details of power embedded in material design but shifts the attention to the technologies and attending forms of power that have been experimented with in the three humanitarian endeavours presented in the book In doing so the book provides new information about aspects of liberal humanitarianism that contemporary critical analyses have largely neglected This book will be of interest to students of humanitarian studies peace and conflict studies critical security studies and IR in general
