Signs and Symptoms of Anaphylactic reaction - Answer Skin: pruritis, urticaria, angiodema, eythema,

Wheezing, coughing, sensation of narrowed airway, stridor, SOB, Tachycardia, Hypotension, Feeling of Doom, Respiratory Arrest, Cardiac Arrest.

3 main drugs for Anaphylactic Reaction - Answer Epinephrine(SC or IM), Glucocorticoids, Antihistamine(Benadryl IM or IV)

Paradoxical Drug Reaction - Answer opposite of expected or intended effect

synergistic effect - Answer acting together for greater effect, enhances effect so that combined action is greater than sum of each acting separately

Half-life of Drug - Answer length of time required for the plasma concentration of a drug to decrease by one-half after administration, the time it takes for drug to be metabolized and plasma concentration to decrease by one half.

Librium/chlordiazepoxide - Answer A benzodiazepine used for anti-anxiety, used for alcohol withdrawal

Benzodiazapine List - Answer alprazolam(xanax), lorazepam(Ativan), diazepam (valium), clonazepam (Klonopin) Oxazepam (Serax) Chlordiazepoxide (Librium)

Benzodiazepine antidote - Answer Flumazenil/Romazicon

Benzodiazepines Action/Use - Answer Decreases neuronal excitability in brain--- CNS depression. Indications: anxiety, sedation, sleep, seizures

Benzodiazepines Adverse Effects - Answer Drowsiness, sedation, lethargy, ataxia, paradoxical excitement, hypotension, CNS depression, dependence

Benzodiazepine Nursing Indications - Answer Administer bedtime to alleviate daytime sedation

No alcohol or other CNS depressants
Avoid driving or operating machinery
Don't stop abruptly, taper to avoid withdrawal
Used only short term, long term can cause dependence
