to play rapidly while others like Beethoven's Moonlight Sonata are much slower but will test your musical abilities in other ways. The other pieces in the book are Prelude No 2 in C minor and Inventions No 4 and No 6 by J S Bach. Flight of the Bumblebee by Korsakov, Perpetual Motion and Carnival of Venice by Paganini and Toccata for Piano or Harpsichord by Paradisi. Classical Masterpieces for Banjo is written in tablature only in standard G tuning gDGBD using three finger banjo technique in the traditional melodic and single string style.
