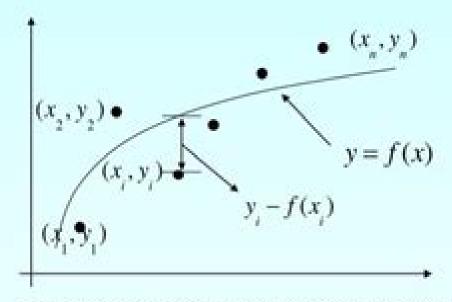


Figure. Nonlinear regression model for discrete y vs. x data
