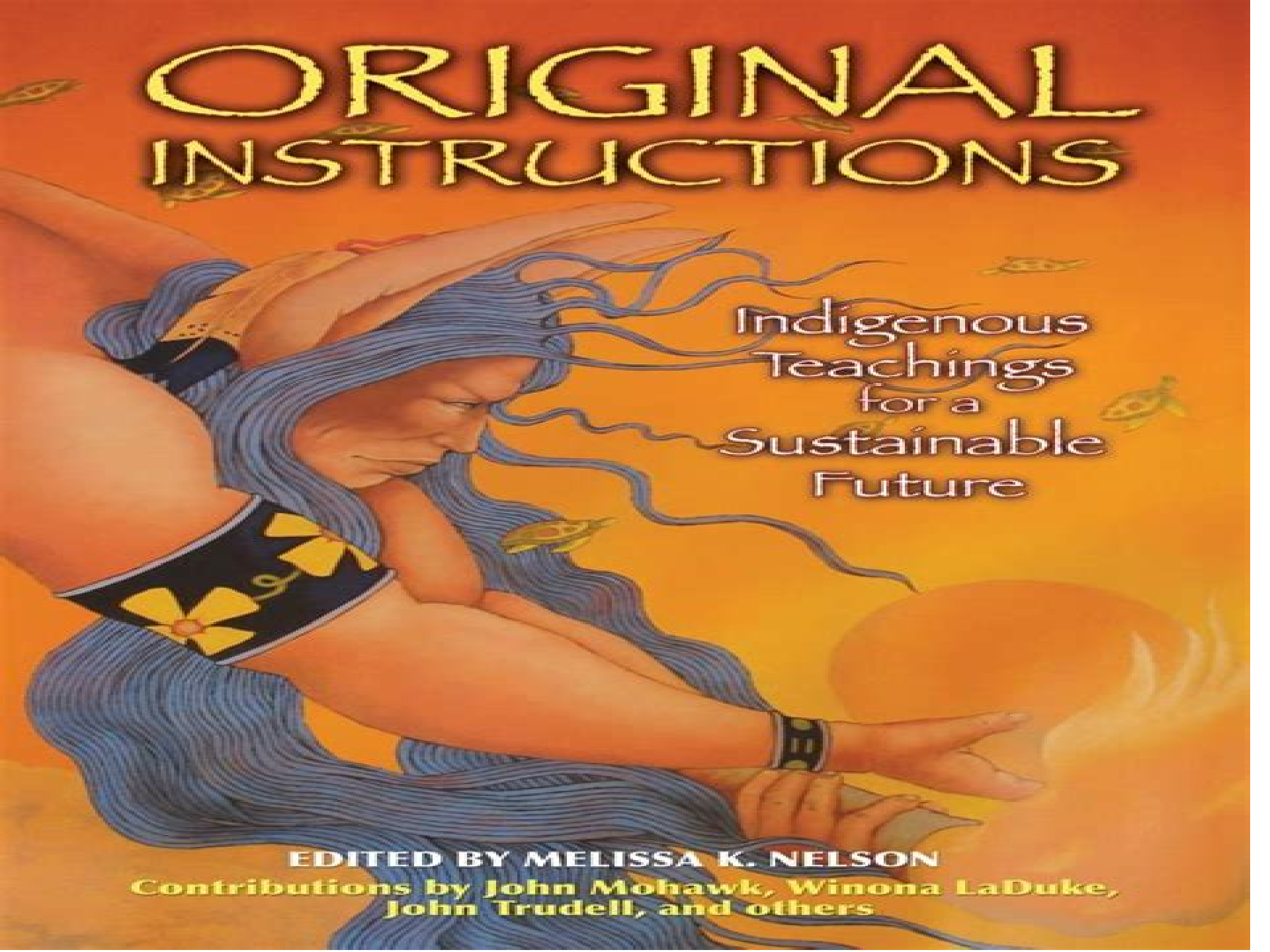

Dina Gilio-Whitaker, 2025-10-07 An investigation into how Native American identity became a commodity from cultural appropriation to ethnic fraud to disenrollment Settler capitalism has been so effective that the very identities of Indigenous people have been usurped misconstrued and weaponized In *Who Gets to Be Indian* scholar and writer Dina Gilio Whitaker Colville Confederated Tribes explores how ethnic fraud and the commodification of Indianness has resulted in mass confusion about what it means to be Indigenous in the United States As an entry point to the seemingly intractable problem of ethnic fraud Gilio Whitaker critically looks to the film industry including a case study of Sacheen Littlefeather who is most known as the Native American woman that rejected an Oscar on behalf of Marlon Brando in 1973 though later revealed she was not who she said she was Gilio Whitaker argues that this pretendian phenomenon originated in Southern California when the United States was forcing assimilation of Indians into white America culturally but also into its capitalist economic system With Indianness becoming a marketized commodity in the Hollywood film business the field became open to anyone who could convincingly adopt an Indian persona Deeply researched using socio historical analysis Gilio Whitaker offers insights from her own experiences grappling with identity to provide clarity and help readers understand how the commodification of Indianness have ultimately left many people of legitimate American Indian heritage to be disconnected from their tribes Personal and compelling Gilio Whitaker takes settler capitalism to task and helps us better understand how we got here in order to counteract the abuses of pretendianism and disenrollment

Epistemic Justice, Mindfulness, and the Environmental Humanities Janelle Adsit, 2021-11-29 *Epistemic Justice Mindfulness and the Environmental Humanities* explores how contemplative pedagogies and mindfulness can be used in the classroom to address epistemic and environmental injustice In recent years there has been a groundswell of interest in contemplative pedagogies in higher education with increasing attention from the environmental sciences environmental humanities and sustainability studies Teachers and writers have demonstrated how mindfulness practices can be a key to anti oppression and anti racist efforts both in and out of the classroom Not all forms of contemplative pedagogy are suited for this anti colonial and anti oppressive resistance however Simply adopting mindfulness practices in the classroom is not enough to dislodge and dismantle white supremacy in higher education *Epistemic Justice Mindfulness and the Environmental Humanities* advocates for mindfulness practices that affirm multiple epistemologies and cultural traditions Written for educators in the

environmental humanities and other related disciplines the chapters interrogate the western uptake of mindfulness practices and suggest anti colonial and anti oppressive methods for bringing mindfulness into the classroom The chapters also discuss what mindfulness practices have to offer to the pursuit of a culturally relevant pedagogy This highly applied and practical text will be an insightful read for educators in the environmental humanities and across the liberal arts disciplines

Roots of Our Renewal Clint Carroll, 2015-05-30 Honorable Mention Labriola Center American Indian National Book Award In *Roots of Our Renewal* Clint Carroll tells how Cherokee people have developed material spiritual and political ties with the lands they have inhabited since removal from their homelands in the southeastern United States Although the forced relocation of the late 1830s had devastating consequences for Cherokee society Carroll shows that the reconstituted Cherokee Nation west of the Mississippi eventually cultivated a special connection to the new land a connection that is reflected in its management of natural resources Until now scant attention has been paid to the interplay between tribal natural resource management programs and governance models Carroll is particularly interested in indigenous environmental governance along the continuum of resource based and relationship based practices and relates how the Cherokee Nation while protecting tribal lands is also incorporating associations with the nonhuman world Carroll describes how the work of an elders advisory group has been instrumental to this goal since its formation in 2008 An enrolled citizen of the Cherokee Nation Carroll draws from his ethnographic observations of Cherokee government community partnerships during the past ten years He argues that indigenous appropriations of modern state forms can articulate alternative ways of interacting with and governing the environment

Places that the map can't contain: Poetics in the Anthropocene Julia Fiedorczuk, Paweł Piszczatowski, 2023-07-10 Inspired by Lynn Keller s notion of the self conscious Anthropocene the book sets out to consider poetry as a privileged space for rethinking our basic epistemological assumptions Poetry does not have the kind of agency a direct political intervention has in fact as W H Auden famously put it poetry makes nothing happen On the other hand poetry is crucial when it comes to awakening our individual and collective imagination Considering the statement by Lawrence Buell that the current ecological crisis is in the first place a crisis of the imagination this function of poetry comes through as particularly important

Affordances in Everyday Life Zakaria Djebbara, 2022-08-27 The concept of affordances is being increasingly used in fields beyond ecological psychology to reveal previously unexplored interdisciplinary relationships These fields include engineering robotics artificial intelligence neuroscience urban theory architecture computer science and much more As the concept is adapted for its relational meaning between an agent and the environment or object the meaning of the term has changed to fit the customs of the adapting field This book maps the different shades of the term and brings insights into how it is

operationalized by providing short accessible essays regardless of background Each contribution addresses big questions around this topic such as the application of the concept on ongoing research how to measure or identify affordances as well as other reflective questions about the future of affordances in the field The book is envisioned to be read by non experts students and researchers from several disciplines and fills the need for summarization across disciplines As the many adaptations flourished from the same psychological concept this book also aims to function as a catalyst and motivation for reinterpreting the concepts for new directions Compared to existing books this book aims not to span the vertical dimension of field by taking a deep dive into a niche field instead this book aims to have a wide horizontal span highlighting a common concept shared by an increasing number of fields namely affordances As such this book takes a different approach by attempting to summarize the different emerging applications and definitions of the concept and make them accessible to non experts students and researchers regardless of background and level

Pretty, 2010 There is a growing recognition that the diversity of life comprises both biological and cultural diversity But this division is not universal and in many cases has been deepened by the common disciplinary divide between the natural and social sciences and our apparent need to manage and control nature This book goes beyond divisive definitions and investigates the bridges linking biological and cultural diversity The international team of authors explore the common drivers of loss and argue that policy responses should target both forms of diversity in a novel integrative approach to conservation thus reducing the gap between science policy and practice While conserving nature alongside human cultures presents unique challenges this book forcefully shows that any hope for saving biological diversity is predicated on a concomitant effort to appreciate and protect cultural diversity

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
