- symbol is T; unit is °C

heat:

- total amount of kinetic energy that flows because of a difference in temperature
- depends on mass of sample
- symbol is Q; unit is J (1 J = 4.18 cal)

Kinetic energy is energy in motion

Potential energy is store

- Potential energy is hiding and cannot be measured
- Only changes in P.E. can be measured.

specific heat capacity:

- amount of energy required to raise the temperature of 1 gram of substance 1 °C
- symbol is c; unit is J/g°C

When heat (Q) is absorbed by a system, part of it (C) goes into storage as potential energy and part of it is used to make the molecules move around more, raising the temperature ( $\Delta t$ ).
