The language is a direct, straightforward form of communication, unadorned by the metaphorical, ornate, or highly ornate words, or by a flowery, poetic, or highly ornate, and only necessary to convey meaning. The language is so direct that it is often used in the military, in the legal system, and in the medical field.
