A time zone is a region that observes a uniform standard of time. While some countries have a single time zone, other countries like the United States span several time zones.

If it's 1:00 in the Pacific time zone, it's 2:00 in the mountain time zone, 3:00 in the central time zone, and 4:00 in the eastern time zone.
