Cultivate a positive mindset by counting your blessings daily.

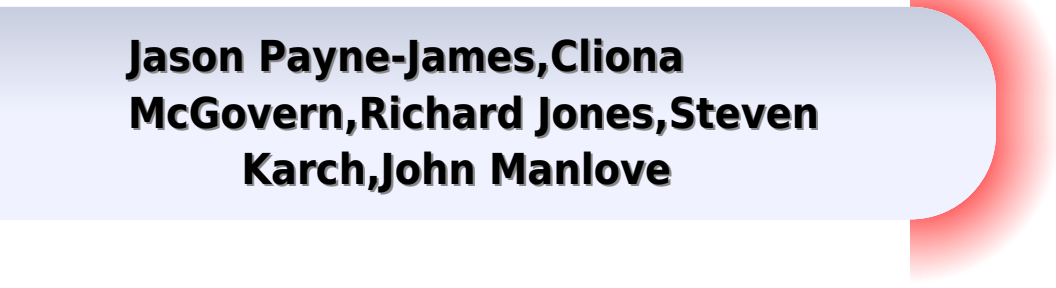
