**Negotiating Corruption** Laura Routley, 2015-12-14 Negotiating Corruption demands that we think again about corruption in Africa It problematises the framing of African corruption as a phenomenon that emerges from a clash between two sets of norms Moreover it highlights the colonial legacies of this frame which situates African corruption within continually recurring debates about the political inclusion or banishment of others NGOs are characterised as intermediaries between the local and the international and between the state and the population In both of these roles they are understood to reform governance by bringing about changes in culture and instituting bureaucratic norms They have therefore been seen as part of the apparatus of a global liberal governmentality.
