Many such as the Chicago Tribune's WGN are still in operation. By 1940 newspapers owned 30 percent of America's radio stations. The debates between corporations, policymakers, and critics over how to regulate these new kinds of media businesses ultimately structured the channels of information distribution in the United States and determined who would control the institutions undergirding American society and politics. *Sound Business* is a timely examination of the connections between media ownership, content, and distribution, one that both expands our understanding of mid-twentieth century America and offers lessons for the digital age.
