Babies breathe much faster than adults, with 40-60 breaths per minute while awake.

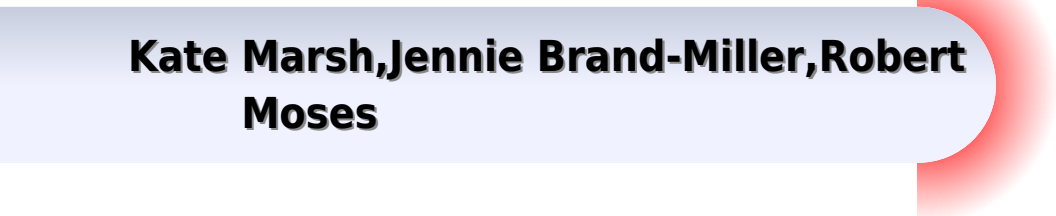
