

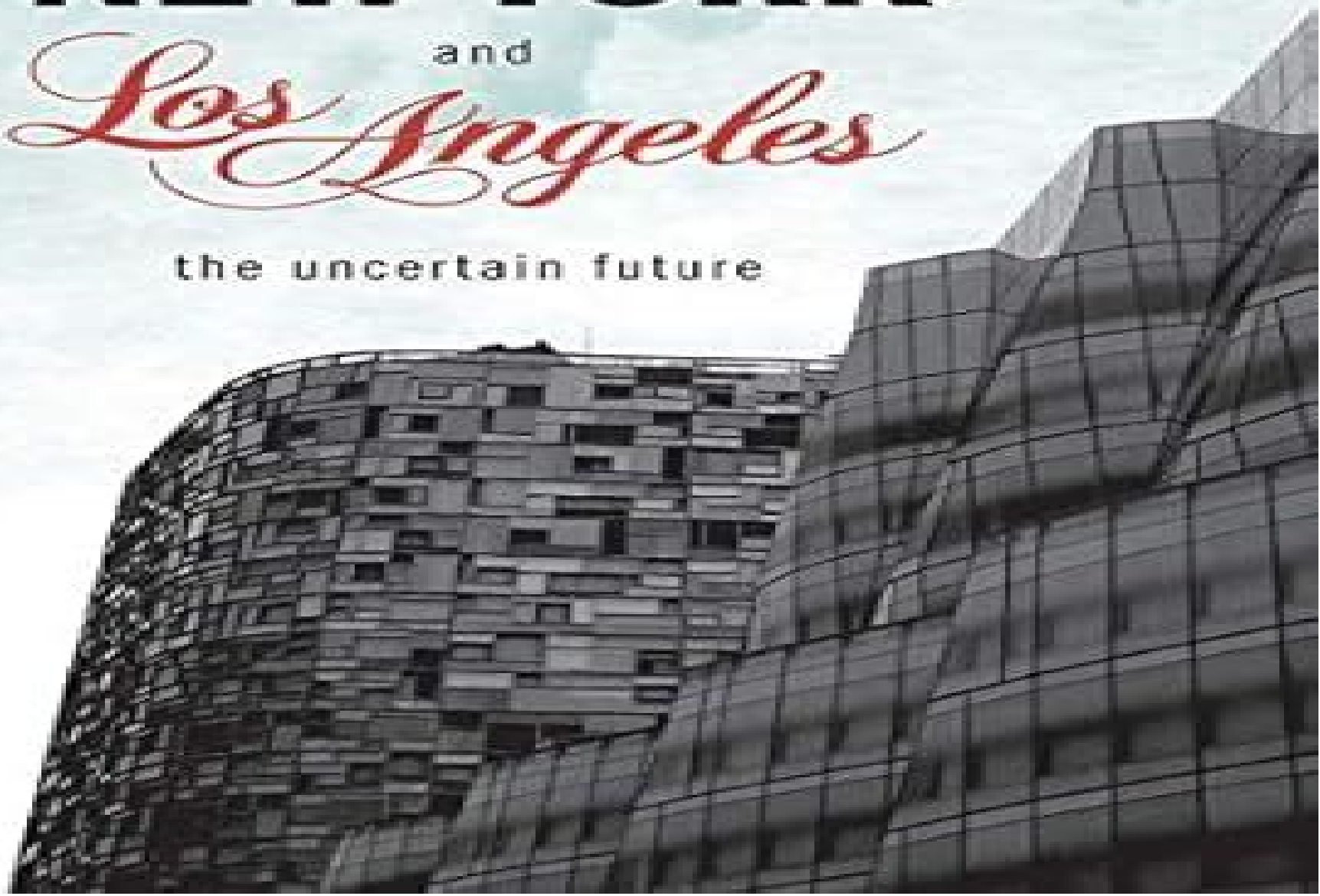

interviews with community residents and leaders and ethnographic observation this book argues that the revitalization in Northeast LA by arts leaders and neighborhood activists marks a departure in the political culture from the older civic engagement to more socially progressive coalition work involving preservationists environmentalists citizen protestors and arts organizers Finally Lin explores how accelerated gentrification and mass displacement of Latino a and working class households in the 2010s has sparked new rounds of activism as the community grapples with new class conflicts and racial divides in the struggle to self determine its future
