Andrews, 1992 Michigan in Literature is a guide to more than one thousand literary and dramatic works set in Michigan from its pre territorial days to the present Imaginative narrative dramatic and lyrical creations that have Michigan settings characters subjects and themes are organized into sixteen chapters on topics such as Indians in Michigan settlers who came to Michigan diversity in the state the timber industry the Great Lakes crime in Michigan literature Detroit and Michigan poetry In this most complete work to date Clarence Andrews has assembled the literary reputation of a state He illustrates with a wide variety of literary works that Michigan is more than just a builder of automobiles a producer of apples and cherries a supplier of copper and lumber and the home of great athletes It is also a state that has played and continues to play an important role in the production of American literature To qualify for inclusion a work or a significant part of it has to be set in Michigan Andrews shows how novelists dramatists poets and short story writers have created their particular images of Michigan by using and interpreting the history of the state its land and waters people events ideas philosophies and policies sometimes factually sometimes modified or distorted and sometimes fancied or imagined Biographical information is featured about authors editors and compilers who range in fame from Ernest Hemingway and Elmore Leonard to persons long forgotten The published opinions and judgments of reputable critics and scholars are also presented

Aronoff, 1998-12-14 Using espionage as a metaphor for politics John le Carr explores the dilemmas that confront individuals and governments as they act during and in the aftermath of the Cold War His unforgettable characters struggle to maintain personal and professional integrity while facing conflicting personal institutional and ideological loyalties In *The Spy Novels of John le Carré* author Myron Aronoff interprets the ambiguous ethical and political implications of the work of John le Carré revealing him to be one of the most important political writers of our time Aronoff shows how through his writing le Carré poses the difficult question of to what extent are western governments justified in pursuing raison d tat without undermining the very democratic freedoms that they claim to defend He also draws parallels between the self parody of le Carré and that of the seventeenth century Dutch artist Jan Steen and explains how it expresses a unique form of

The Image of Man in C. S. Lewis William Luther White, 2009-01-12 It is in the role of re-mythologizer that C. S. Lewis has been most misunderstood and it is there that his importance lies His was the poetic intensity that saw all hell swallowed by a butterfly with no harm done Of his creation are allegories and myth that express very real elements of life beyond understanding or capture for more than a moment White's 1969 study is the first to examine the entire Lewis corpus and the first to offer such an extensive bibliography To these invaluable aids for Lewis scholars White adds his own training in theology and literary criticism and a sensitivity to the complexities of the artist and the religious man His interpretation of the intricate skeins of belief to be found in Lewis work make this study as significant to the theological as to the literary world

With readings of a broad range of her published works including her final novel *The Blue Flower* Wolfe describes the unfolding of Fitzgerald's writing as a subtle ongoing process He maintains that the novels though plain and rambling at first glance grow fuller stranger and more stirring the more we invest in them He details Fitzgerald's skill at sequencing events so as to unsettle readers and her ability to enhance motifs by not leaning too hard on them Wolfe suggests that Fitzgerald's refusal to overplay effects and emotions while at first puzzling in its disdain for drama turns out to be one of her chief virtues for she enables larger associations to emerge as she keeps big dramatic scenes from interfering with wider patterns

Heinz Liepman had positioned himself on Germany's literary landscape. After fleeing the National Socialists to exile in France, England, and America, he returned to Germany in 1947. The literary agency that he and his wife founded still exists today and is one of the most renowned agencies in the industry. Although Heinz Liepman remained a widely published journalist and radio broadcaster until his death, his name nevertheless fell into oblivion posthumously. Thanks to many years of research and personal contact with several of Liepman's relatives, friends, and colleagues, Wilfried Weinke succeeded in compiling a detailed biographical reconstruction of Liepman's life and work. The abundance of unpublished letters and photographs not only illustrates the hardships of exile but also depicts the arduousness of building one's life back up in post-war Germany.

Contemporary American Women Writers Catherine Rainwater, William J. Scheick, 2021-05-11. Ann Beattie, Annie Dillard, Maxine Hong Kingston, Toni Morrison, Cynthia Ozick, Grace Paley, Marge Piercy, Anne Redmon, Anne Tyler, and Alice Walker all seem to be especially concerned with narrative management. The ten essays in this book raise new and intriguing questions about the ways these leading women writers appropriate and transform generic norms and ultimately revise literary tradition to make it more inclusive of female experience, vision, and expression. The contributors to this volume discover diverse narrative strategies. Beattie, Dillard, Paley, and Redmon, in divergent ways, rely heavily upon narrative gaps, surfaces, and silences, often suggesting depths which are lamentably absent from modern experience or which mysteriously elude language. For Kingston and Walker, verbal assertiveness is the focus of narratives depicting the gradual empowerment of female protagonists who learn to speak themselves into existence. Ozick and Tyler disrupt conventional reader expectations of the anti-novel and the family novel, respectively. Finally, Morrison's and Piercy's works reveal how traditional narrative forms such as the Bildungsroman and the soap opera are adaptable to feminist purposes. In examining the writings of these ten important women authors, this book illuminates a significant moment in literary history when women's voices are profoundly reshaping American literary tradition.

Crockett Johnson and Ruth Krauss Philip Nel, 2012-07-30. Winner of the Children's Literature Association's 2014 Honor Book Award, Crockett Johnson (born David Johnson Leisk, 1906-1975) and Ruth Krauss (1901-1993) were a husband-and-wife team that created such popular children's books as *The Carrot Seed* and *How to Make an Earthquake*. Separately, Johnson created the enduring children's classic *Harold and the Purple Crayon*, and the groundbreaking comic strip *Barnaby*. Krauss wrote over a dozen children's books, illustrated by others, and pioneered the use of spontaneous, loose-tongued kids in children's literature. Together, Johnson and Krauss's style, whimsical writing, clear and minimalist drawing, and a child's point of view is among the most revered and influential in children's literature and cartooning, inspiring the work of Maurice Sendak, Charles M. Schulz, Chris Van Allsburg, and Jon Scieszka. This critical biography examines their lives and careers, including their separate achievements when not collaborating. Using correspondence, sketches, contemporary newspaper and magazine accounts, archived, and personal interviews, author Philip Nel draws a compelling portrait of a couple whose output encompassed children's literature, comics, graphic design, and the

fine arts Their mentorship of now famous illustrator Maurice Sendak *Where the Wild Things Are* is examined at length as is the couple's appeal to adult contemporaries such as Duke Ellington and Dorothy Parker Defiantly leftist in an era of McCarthyism and Cold War paranoia Johnson and Krauss risked collaborations that often contained subtly rendered liberal themes Indeed they were under FBI surveillance for years Their legacy of considerable success invites readers to dream and to imagine drawing paths that take them anywhere they want to go *Henry Hazlitt*, 1994 [What America Read](#) Gordon Hutner, 2009-11-05 Despite the vigorous study of modern American fiction today's readers are only familiar with a partial shelf of a vast library Gordon Hutner describes the distorted canonized history of the twentieth century American novel as a record of modern classics insufficiently appreciated in their day but recuperated by scholars in order to shape the grand tradition of Hemingway Fitzgerald and Faulkner In presenting literary history this way Hutner argues scholars have forgotten a rich treasury of realist novels that recount the story of the American middle class's confrontation with modernity Reading these novels now offers an extraordinary opportunity to witness debates about what kind of nation America would become and what place its newly dominant middle class would have and Hutner suggests should also lead us to wonder how our own contemporary novels will be remembered **Genre-Busting Dark Comedies of the 1970s** Wes D.

Gehring, 2016-03-09 This examination of dark comedies of the 1970s focuses on films which concealed black humor behind a misleading genre label *All That Jazz* 1979 is a musical about death hardly Fred and Ginger territory This masking goes beyond misnomer to a breaking of formula that director Robert Altman called anti genre Altman's *MASH* 1970 ridiculed the military establishment in general the Vietnam War in particular under the guise of a standard military service comedy The picaresque Western *Little Big Man* 1970 turned the bluecoats vs Indians formula upside down the audience roots for the Indians instead of the cavalry The book covers 12 essential films including *Harold and Maude* 1971 *Slaughterhouse Five* 1972 *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest* 1975 and *Being There* 1979 with notes on *A Clockwork Orange* 1971 These films reveal a compounding complexity that reinforces the absurdity at the heart of dark comedy

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
