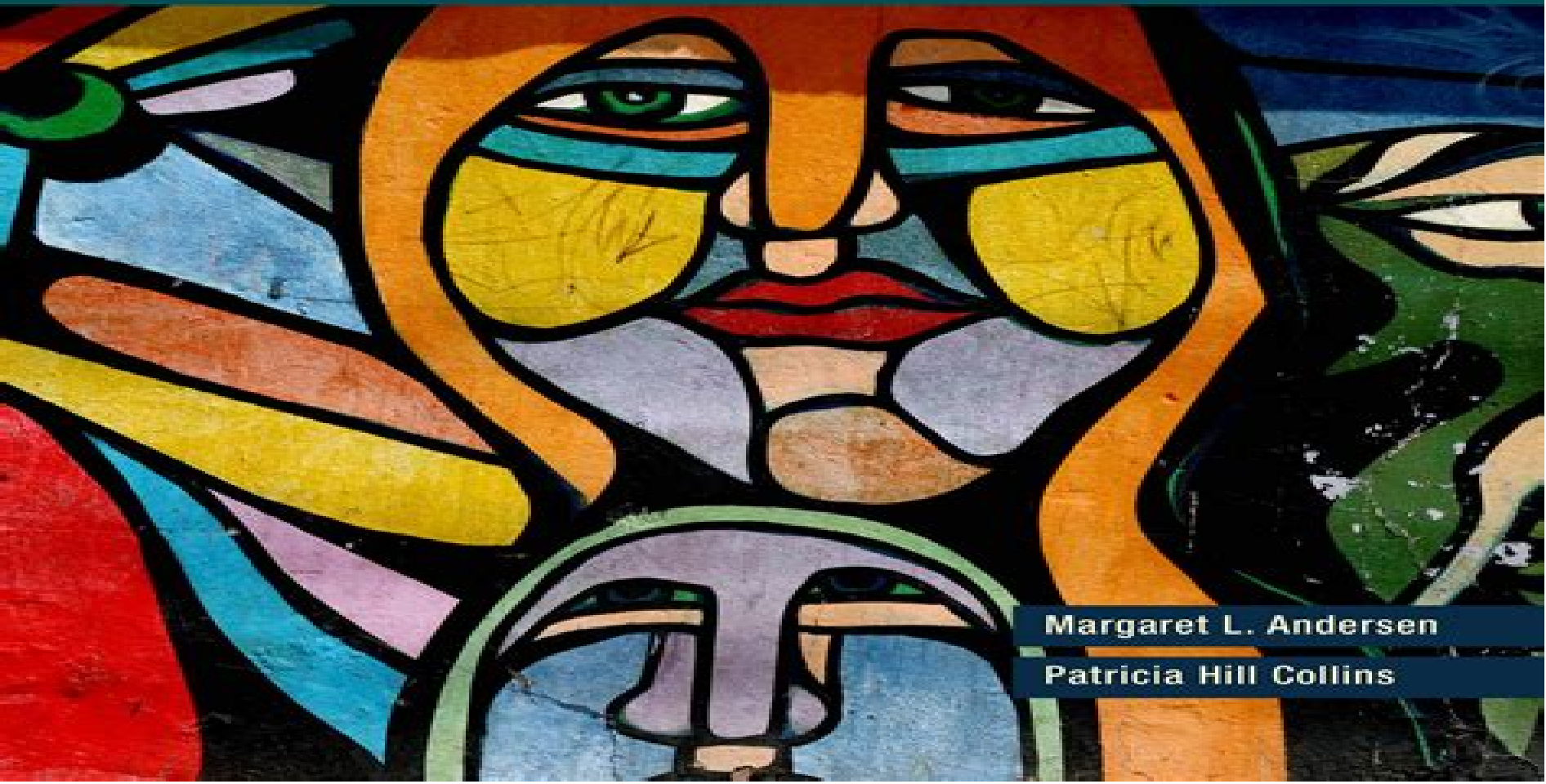

The Politics of Gender Justice at the International Criminal Court Louise A. Chappell, 2016 This book examines the gender justice design features of the Rome Statute the foundation of the International Criminal Court and assessing the effectiveness of the statute s implementation in the first decade of the court s operation Chappell argues that although the ICC has provided mixed outcomes for gender justice there have also been a number of important breakthroughs particularly in regards to support for female judges Gender Issues and International Legal Standards. Contemporary Perspectives Adriana Di Stefano, 2010-10 *Feminist Engagement with International Criminal Law* Eithne Dowds, 2020-01-23 This work introduces and further develops the feminist strategy of norm transfer the proposal that feminist informed standards created at the level of international criminal law make their way into domestic contexts Situating this strategy within the complementarity regime of the International Criminal Court ICC it is argued that there is an opportunity for dialogue and debate around the contested aspects of international norms as opposed to uncritical acceptance The book uses the crime of rape as a case study and offers a new perspective on one of the most contentious debates within international and domestic criminal legal feminism the relationship between consent and coercion in the definition of rape In analysing the ICC definition of rape it is argued that the omission of consent as an explicit element is flawed Arguing that the definition is in need of revision to explicitly include a context sensitive notion of consent the book goes further setting out draft legislative amendments to the ICC Elements of Crimes definition of rape and its Rules of Procedure and Evidence Turning its attention to the domestic landscape the book drafts amendments to the United Kingdom UK Sexual Offences Act 2003 and to the Youth Justice and Criminal Evidence Act 1999 thereby showing how the revised version of the ICC definition can be applied in context of the UK **Body Politics in Development** Wendy Harcourt, 2013-04-04 Body Politics in Development sets out to define body politics as a key political and mobilizing force for human rights in the last two decades This passionate and engaging book reveals how once tabooed issues such as rape gender based violence and sexual and reproductive rights have emerged into the public arena as critical grounds of contention and struggle Engaging in the latest feminist thinking and action the book describes the struggles around body politics for people living in economic and socially vulnerable communities and covers a broad range of gender and development issues including fundamentalism sexualities and new technologies from diverse viewpoints The book s originality comes through the author s rich experience and engagement in feminist activism and global body politics and was winner of the 2010 FWSA Book Prize *Women's Access to Transitional Justice in Timor-Leste* Noemí Pérez Vásquez, 2022-06-16 Seeing the role of transitional justice as an area of contestation this book focuses on the principle of equality guaranteed in the access to transitional justice mechanisms By raising women s experiences in dealing with the law and policies as well as the implications of community and family practices during post conflict situations the book shows how these mechanisms may have been implemented mechanically without considering the

different intersections of discrimination the public and private divides that exist in the local context or the stereotypes and values of international and national actors The book argues that without unpacking the barriers in the administration of transitional justice the different mechanisms that are implemented in a post conflict situation may set a higher threshold for the participation of women Moreover by taking into account women s perceptions of justice it further argues that scholars have paid insufficient attention to the welfare structures that are produced after a conflict particularly the pensions of veterans Going beyond the focus on sexual violence a relationship between the violations and post conflict economic justice may have longer term consequences for women since it perpetuates their inequality and lack of recognition in times of peace The use of transitional justice may thus exacerbate the invisibility of and discrimination against certain sections of the population Inspired by the work of Hannah Arendt and based on extensive field research in Timor Leste the book has larger implications for the overarching debate on the social consequences of transitional justice

Gender, Human Security and the United Nations Natalie Florea Hudson, 2009-09-22 This book examines the relationship between women gender and the international security agenda exploring the meaning of security in terms of discourse and practice as well as the larger goals and strategies of the global women s movement Today many complex global problems are being located within the security logic From the environment to HIV AIDS state and non state actors have made a practice out of securitizing issues that are not conventionally seen as such As most prominently demonstrated by the UN Security Council Resolution 1325 2001 activists for women s rights have increasingly framed women s rights and gender inequality as security issues in an attempt to gain access to the international security agenda particularly in the context of the United Nations This book explores the nature and implications of the use of security language as a political framework for women tracing and analyzing the organizational dynamics of women s activism in the United Nations system and how women have come to embrace and been impacted by the security framework globally and locally The book argues that from a feminist and human security perspective efforts to engender the security discourse have had both a broadening and limiting effect highlighting

reasons to be sceptical of securitization as an inherently beneficial strategy Four cases studies are used to develop the core themes 1 the campaign to implement UN Security Council Resolution 1325 2 the strategies utilized by those advocating women s issues in the security arena compared to those advocating for children 3 the organizational development of the UN Development Fund for Women and how it has come to securitize women and 4 the activity of the UN Peacebuilding Commission and its challenges in gendering its security approach The work will be of interest to students of critical security gender studies international organizations and international relations in general Natalie Florea Hudson received her PhD in Political Science from the University of Connecticut and is an Assistant Professor at the University of Dayton She specializes in gender and international relations human rights international security studies and international law and organization
