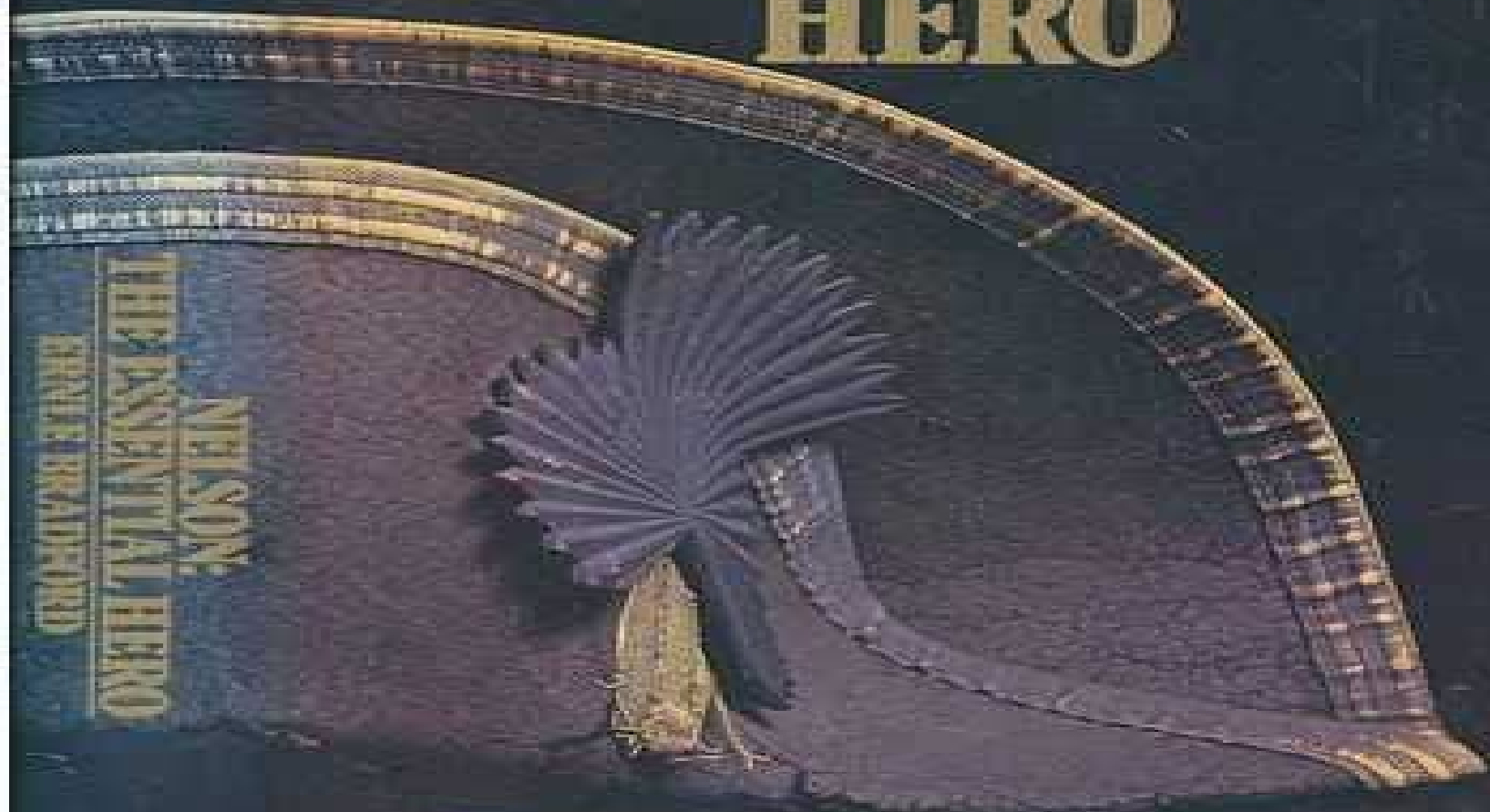

Over the course of its history England has engaged in an uncountable number of battles but none of her military heroes has had a greater military legacy than Admiral Lord Horatio Nelson 1st Viscount Nelson 1st Duke of Bront Whether traveling to Trafalgar Square or one of the hundreds of pubs named after him seemingly it becomes easy to believe that no Briton has cast as long a shadow Nelson is known across the world for his decisive victory at Trafalgar made all the more legendary by the fact that he was mortally wounded at the height of his greatest feat And it is understandable that any man who could thwart Napoleon's ambitions as well as Nelson did would earn a place in the history books But Nelson embodied every virtue of his homeland as a dashing courageous military officer who was impeccably cultured and the best at what he did Indeed as the personification of the supremacy of the Royal Navy the man and his life had a powerful resonance well before his death Before Trafalgar Nelson had already earned enduring fame for the British victory at the Battle of the Nile In 1798 he was given command of a small squadron and sent ahead to Gibraltar and eventually given instructions to hunt down and destroy Napoleon's fleet An initial review of France's naval forces had led Napoleon to conclude his navy could not hope to outfight the power of the Royal Navy which had been the dominant naval power for centuries so he was forced to look elsewhere After months of planning Napoleon crafted a scheme to attack and conquer Egypt denying the British easy access to their colonies in India with the ultimate goal of linking up with the Sultan Tipoo in India itself and defeating the British in the field there Napoleon sailed with Admiral Brueys and 30 000 troops that June heading for Egypt Notionally part of the Ottoman Empire Egypt was de facto a weak independent regime run by the breakaway Mamelukes For France it offered an overland route to India and a chance to beat Britain at her own game via economic strangulation Nelson however could only speculate at French intentions Whatever the destination of the French fleet he sought a battle of annihilation the culmination of all he had learned as an officer and admiral Only by that means could Britain secure the Mediterranean and neutralize the threat of a French army operating overseas His understanding was icily accurate

individuals *The Man Who Discovered Antarctica* Sheila Bransfield, 2019-04-30 The definitive biography of the British naval officer who found the Antarctic shoreline in the early nineteenth century Captain Cook claimed the honor of being the first man to sail into the Antarctic Ocean in 1773 which he circumnavigated the following year Cook though did not see any land and declared that there was no such thing as the Southern Continent Fifty years later an Irishman who d been impressed into the Royal Navy at eighteen and risen through the ranks to the position of master proved Cook wrong discovering and charting parts of the Antarctic shoreline He also discovered Elephant Island and Clarence Island claiming them for the British Crown Edward Bransfield s naval career included taking part in the Bombardment of Algiers in 1816 onboard the 50 gun warship HMS Severn Then in 1817 he was posted to the Royal Navy s Pacific Squadron off Valpara so in Chile and it was while he served there that the skipper of an English whaling ship the Williams was driven south by adverse winds and discovered what came to be known as the South Shetland Islands where Cook had said there was no land Bransfield s superior officer Captain Sherriff decided to investigate further He chartered Williams and sent Bransfield with two midshipmen and a ship s surgeon into the Antarctic and the Irishman sailed into history Despite many parts of Antarctica and an Antarctic survey vessel being named after him and a Royal Mail commemorative stamp issued in his name the full story of this remarkable man and his historic journey have never been told until now Following decades of research Sheila Bransfield MA a member of the UK Antarctic Heritage Trust has produced the definitive biography of one of Britain s greatest maritime explorers The book also includes a foreword by the Trust s patron the Princess Royal Bransfield s meticulous research gives us a detailed account of the daily routines of the Navy and the immense amount of maintenance required of a large wooden warship in the Age of Sail Historical Novel Society **Nelson's Letters to Lady Hamilton and Related Documents** Marianne Czisnik, 2020-09-28 This critical edition of Admiral Nelson s letters to Lady Hamilton is to bring together the important letters of Nelson to Lady Hamilton that have only been published in parts over the last 200 years Only by bringing the letters of Nelson to Lady Hamilton together is it possible to assess their relationship and to present certain insights into Nelson s personality that are not revealed in his official correspondence Thorough research into this side of Nelson s personality and into the nature of his notorious and unconventional relationship with Lady Hamilton has been hampered in the past by a desire not to look too closely at Nelson s personal morality To a considerable extent their relationship was regarded as a challenge to traditional gender roles and it indeed did not conform to stereotypes that are usually attributed to men and women in a heterosexual relationship Lady Hamilton was so obviously lacking in the subservience and passivity expected from women in that era that authors over the course of time started to exclude her in their accounts of the public sphere by reducing her to a private weakness of Nelson s who could be successful at sea where he was far away from the enthralling influence of a manipulating woman The letters in this edition testify how Admiral Nelson s life at sea was not exclusively public nor was Lady Hamilton s life ashore solely private It also shows how the two

In the first half of the sixteenth century, the Ottoman Empire was thought to be invincible. Suleiman the Magnificent, the Ottoman sultan, had expanded his empire from western Asia to southeastern Europe and North Africa. To secure control of the Mediterranean between these territories and launch an offensive into western Europe, Suleiman needed the small but strategically crucial island of Malta. But Suleiman's attempt to take the island from the Holy Roman Empire's Knights of St John would emerge as one of the most famous and brutal military defeats in history. Forty-two years earlier, Suleiman had been victorious against the Knights of St John when he drove them out of their island fortress at Rhodes. The Roman grand master La Vallette responded by having his Ottoman captives beheaded. Then the battle for Malta began in earnest, no quarter asked, none given.
