Van Dellen, 2009 Maps of towns roads parks and other landmarks along nearly 360 miles of the river s course      **Riverwoods** Charles Kruvand, 2018-09-05 In this stunning photographic tribute to one of Texas most intriguing and perhaps least understood rivers Riverwoods Exploring the Wild Neches takes readers on a unique adventure along and sometimes into the wild and murky waters of the Neches River The Neches flows through the heart of East Texas past primordial bottomland forests timber and oil industries and elusive denizens humans alligators bobcats and herons Although the river and its watershed have inspired authors artists and photographers it can also seem impenetrable intimidating or just plain unsightly to outsiders Spending many days canoeing the river and nights camping on the banks Charles Kruvand was drawn to the complicated allure of the Neches river and woods Once common across the southeastern United States the Neches bottomland forests exemplify an ecosystem that has almost passed out of existence Thad Sitton an East Texas native and noted historian opens the book with an introduction to the historical cultural and ecological significance of the Neches River He takes readers through time from early Native American inhabitants to Spanish and Anglo settlers to present day East Texans He also describes the environmental battles fought over preserving parts of the river woodlands surrounding the waterway and wildlife that have depended on the river for sustenance Through beautiful photographs and stirring recollections of his trip along the river Charles Kruvand weaves a rare portrait of one of the last wild rivers in Texas      The Nueces River Margie Crisp, 2017-03-27 First appearing on early Spanish maps as the R o Escondido or hidden river and later named R o de las Nueces after the abundant pecan trees along its banks the Nueces today is a stream of seeming contradictions a river that runs above and below ground a geographic reminder of a history both noble and egregious and a spring fed stream transformed into a salty steep sided channel From its fresh clear headwaters on the Edwards Plateau Margie Crisp and William B Montgomery follow the river through the mesquite and prickly pear of the South Texas Plains to the river s end in Nueces and Corpus Christi Bays on the Gulf of Mexico With vivid prose and paintings they record their travels as they explore the length of the river on foot kayak and fishing boat ultimately weaving a vivid portrait of today s Nueces Capturing the river s subtle beauty abundant wildlife diverse culture and unique history of exploration conflict and settlement they reveal the untold story of this enigmatic river with passion humor and reverence To learn more about The Meadows Center for Water and the Environment sponsors of this book s series please click here      **Running the River** Wes Ferguson, 2014-02-27 Growing up near the Sabine journalist Wes Ferguson like most East Texans steered clear of its murky debris filled waters where alligators lived in the backwater sloughs and an occasional body was pulled from some out of the way crossing The Sabine held a reputation as a haunt for a handful of hunters and loggers more than a few water moccasins swarms of mosquitoes and the occasional black bear lumbering through swamp oak and cypress knees But when Ferguson set out to do a series of newspaper stories on the upper portion of

the river he and photographer Jacob Croft Botter were entranced by the river's subtle beauty and the solitude they found there. They came to admire the self-described river rats who hunted, fished, and swapped stories along the muddy water plain. Folk who love the Sabine as much as Hill Country vacationers love the clear waters of the Guadalupe. Determined to travel the rest of the river, Ferguson and Botter loaded their gear and launched into the stretch of river that charts the line between the states and ends at the Gulf of Mexico. **User's Guide to CHEAPO II** Joseph E. Horn, 1986. **The Blanco River** Wes Ferguson, 2017-02-22. For eighty-seven miles, the swift and shallow Blanco River winds through the Texas Hill Country. Its water is clear and green, darkened by frequent pools. Wes Ferguson and Jacob Botter have paddled, walked, and waded the Blanco. They have explored its history, people, wildlife, and the natural beauty that surprises everyone who experiences this river. Described as the defining element in some of the Hill Country's most beautiful scenery, the Blanco flows both above and below ground, part of a network of rivers and aquifers that sustains the region's wildlife and millions of humans alike. However, overpumping and prolonged drought have combined to weaken the Blanco's flow and sustenance, and in 2000, for the first time in recorded history, the river's most significant feeder spring, Jacob's Well, briefly ceased to flow. It

Estuaries are defined by mixing of river and sea water thus freshwater inflow is a key driver of estuary ecosystem structure and function. While there is much concern about water quality there is much less about water quantity. As water is diverted for human use less is flowing to the coast which threatens estuary ecosystems. Some jurisdictions are now setting inflow standards but there is no consensus on how to identify how much freshwater an estuary needs. There is a climatic gradient along the northwestern Gulf of Mexico coast and estuaries vary from hydrologically positive to neutral to negative and this makes the Texas coast the ideal place to study how ecological processes vary with freshwater inflow. An estuary comparison approach is used in this open access work to examine hydrology, circulation, salinity, nutrients, carbonate, dissolved oxygen, plankton, nekton, benthos, and habitat dynamics and responses across varying hydrological regimes.
