Selected studies Romance in Medieval England conference The Medieval Greek Romance Roderick Beaton, 2012-05-31 First published by CUP in 1989 The Medieval Greek Romance provides basic information for the non specialist about Greek fiction during the period 1071-1453 as well as proposing new solutions to problems that have vexed previous generations of scholars Roderick Beaton applies sophisticated methods of literary analysis to the material and the bridges of the artificial gap which has separated Byzantine literature in a form of ancient Greek as both homogenous and of a high level of literary sophistication Throughout consideration is given to relations and interconnections with similar literature in western Europe As most of the texts discussed are not available in English translation the argument is illustrated by lucid plot summaries and extensive quotation accompanied by literal English renderings For this edition The Medieval Greek Romance has been revised throughout and expanded with the addition of an Afterword which assesses and responds to recent work on the subject

Reading Popular Romance in Early Modern England Lori Humphrey Newcomb, 2001-12-26 With the expansion of the publishing industry between the sixteenth and eighteenth centuries reading for pleasure became possible for an increasing number of people not just the wealthy and educated The growth of the book trade produced alongside elite literature a parallel popular literature Lori Humphrey Newcomb examines the proliferation of romances in early modern England as well as their vilification by elite writers Using as her case study Robert Greene's Pandosto 1585 an Elizabethan prose romance that inspired Shakespeare's late play The Winter's Tale she shows that the two forms of literature influenced each other profoundly Because Shakespeare's works are considered timeless literary achievements critics have distanced his plays from his romantic sources a separation that until now has gone unquestioned Newcomb undermines this assumption providing a fascinating account of an early bestseller's incarnations over 250 years of literary history

The Alexander Romance in Persia and the East Richard Stoneman, Kyle Erickson, Ian Richard Netton, 2012 Alexander the Great of Macedon was no stranger to controversy in his own time Conqueror of the Greek states of Egypt and of the Persian Empire as well as many of the principalities of the Indus Valley he nevertheless became revered as well as vilified Was he simply a destroyer of the ancient civilizations and religions of these regions or was he a hero of the Persian dynasties and of Islam The conflicting views that were taken of him in the Middle East in his own time and the centuries that followed are still reflected in the tensions that exist between east and west today The story of Alexander became the subject of legend in the medieval west but was perhaps even more pervasive in the east The Alexander Romance was translated into Syriac in the sixth century and may have become current in Persia as early as

the third century AD From these beginnings it reached into the Persian national epic the Shahnameh into Jewish traditions and into the Quran and subsequent Arab romance The papers in this volume all have the aim of deepening our understanding of this complex development If we can understand better why Alexander is such an important figure in both east and west we shall be a little closer to understanding what unites two often antipathetic worlds This volume collects the papers delivered at the conference of the same title held at the University of Exeter from July 26-29 2010 More than half the papers were by invited speakers and were designed to provide a systematic view of the subject the remainder were selected for their ability to carry research forward in an integrated way
