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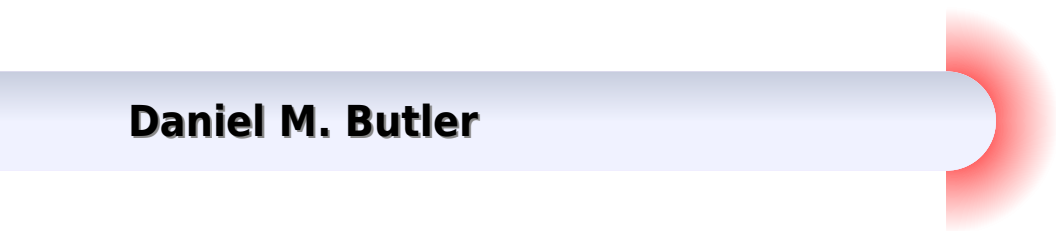

Oversight Representing The Interests Of Blacks And Latinos In Congress:

Oversight Michael D. Minta, 2011-08-08 Oversight answers the question of whether black and Latino legislators better represent minority interests in Congress than white legislators and it is the first book on the subject to focus on congressional oversight rather than roll call voting In this important book Michael Minta demonstrates that minority lawmakers provide qualitatively better representation of black and Latino interests than their white counterparts They are more likely to intervene in decision making by federal agencies by testifying in support of minority interests at congressional oversight hearings Minority legislators write more letters urging agency officials to enforce civil rights policies and spend significant time and effort advocating for solutions to problems that affect all racial and ethnic groups such as poverty inadequate health care fair housing and community development In Oversight Minta argues that minority members of Congress act on behalf of broad minority interests inside and outside their districts because of a shared bond of experience and a sense of linked fate He shows how the presence of black and Latino legislators in the committee room increases the chances that minority perspectives and concerns will be addressed in committee deliberations and also how minority lawmakers are effective at countering negative stereotypes about minorities in policy debates on issues like affirmative action and affordable housing

Congress in Black and White Christian R. Grose, 2011-01-31 The symbolic importance of Barack Obama's election is without question But beyond symbolism does the election of African American politicians matter Grose argues that it does and presents a unified theory of representation Electing African American legislators yields more federal dollars and congressional attention directed toward African American voters However race and affirmative action gerrymandering have no impact on public policy passed in Congress Grose is the first to examine a natural experiment and exceptional moment in history in which black legislators especially in the U S South represented districts with a majority of white constituents This is the first systematic examination of the effect of a legislator's race above and beyond the effect of constituency racial characteristics Grose offers policy prescriptions including the suggestion that voting rights advocates the courts and redistricters draw black decisive districts electorally competitive districts that are likely to elect African Americans

The Politics of African-American Education

Based on the 1,800 largest school districts in the United States over a decade, *The Politics of African American Education* documents the status of African American education and the major role that partisanship plays. The book brings together the most comprehensive database on minority education to date that centers around three arguments. First, partisanship permeates African American education; it affects who is elected to the school board, the racial composition of school administrators and teachers, and the access of African American students to quality education. Second, African American representation matters. The effectiveness of African American representation, however, is enhanced in Democratic districts while representation in Republican districts has little influence. Third, political structures matter, but they are not determinative. Two different structures, election rules and the independent school district, create the rules of the game in US education politics and policy but do not limit others from using those rules to change the outcome.

The Radical Imagination of Black Women Pearl K. Ford Dowe, Pearl K. Ford, 2023. Historically many Black women have viewed political participation as a means to achieve full equality and improve their status in US society. To this end Black women have long engaged in politics through activism, voting mobilization, and seeking office. Since 2016 the number of women, particularly Black women seeking office, has increased dramatically. Including interviews with Black women holding political office at the national, state, and local levels, as well as focus group data, *The Radical Imagination of Black Women* challenges political science's current approach to political ambition by exploring how Black women decide to seek political office. Pearl K. Ford Dowe argues that ambition for Black women cannot be measured only by political candidacies and ascents of the political chain of power. Black women are uniquely positioned within their communities to influence politics and public policy, which stems from unique variables of socialization, gender, and racial identity and marginalization that shape the political attitudes of Black women. Thus Dowe asserts that Black women's political ambition often manifests outside formal politics in activism and community building, a process that is linked to a wider radical vision for a full democracy. This is ambition that occurs in a specific context of marginalization, and both motivation and the conditions surrounding such motivation are critical to understanding the full range of Black women's political work. By focusing on Black women's experiences in elite politics, *The Radical Imagination of Black Women* is a much needed
