

# Boundary Role Plays

A boundary is a limit on what you can do — in other words, it's a line that you cannot (or should not!) cross. We have boundaries all over the place. Are there boundaries at school? What about at home?

Boundaries also exist in relationships. We have personal boundaries — things we don't want other people to do because they **cross a line**. When people cross our boundaries, it can be hurtful and even dangerous.

Sometimes it can be hard to know what people's boundaries are. While some boundaries are universal, others can be different depending on the person or your relationship with them. For example, some people love hugs, but others don't. It's important that we know how to express our personal boundaries to other people.

## Personal boundaries in relationships might look like:

- Respecting someone's personal space — not getting too close.
- Not making comments about someone's appearance.
- Not touching someone (e.g. giving hugs) without their permission.
- Not sharing information about someone else without their permission.
- Respecting that people need time on their own / away from you.
- Keeping your personal information private.
- Respecting other people's belongings.
- Not talking to or accepting requests from strangers online.
