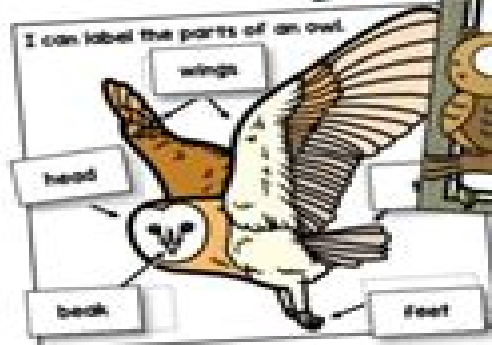

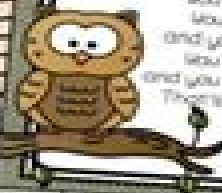


Owl Pokey
