When CBC rank and file employees came to believe their leaders missed a chance to hold on to at least a part of Hockey Night in Canada, a move that could have saved some of their jobs, their disappointment turned to outrage. However, in January 2014 the Maple Leafs crashed hard and so did the ratings for Hockey Night in Canada. It was crushing news for Rogers, with cable cutting already shaping into an existential threat. On top of everything, Strombo bombed as host and the network had to bring MacLean back. Then things got even worse by the middle of the 2015-16 season, the rest of the seven Canadian NHL teams missed the playoffs and ratings fell further, chasing away even more advertising dollars. Simultaneously, viewing habits were changing so quickly no one could predict what would happen next year, let alone in the next decade. Shoalts covers this story from the beginning and Hockey Fight in Canada details every fascinating play in this intersection of sports and business.
