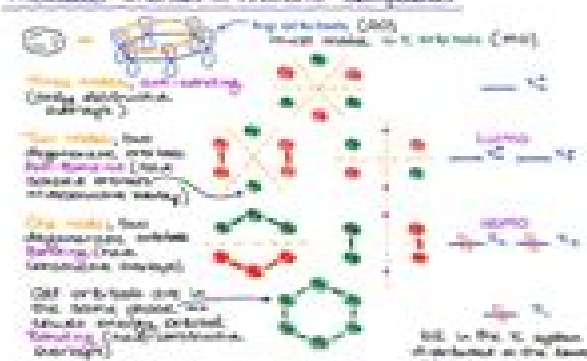
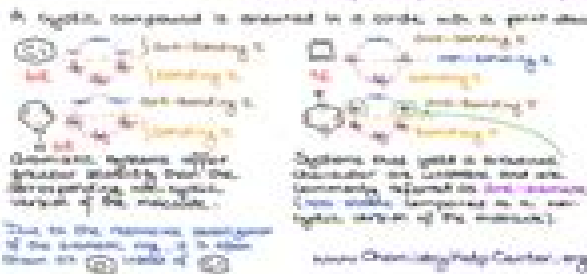


Mechanism of Reaction in Aqueous Compounds



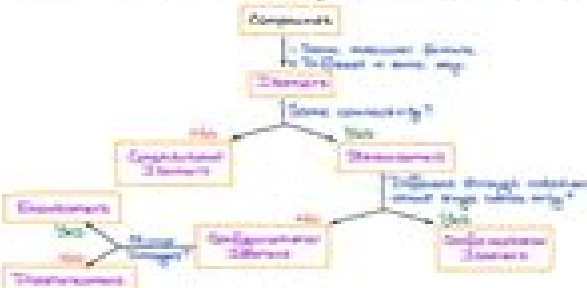
Free Radical Reactions: - free radicals are produced by homolysis of a bond, often initiated by heat or light.



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Summary of Stereochemical Relationships

- Constitutional Isomers:** - completely different molecules
- Conformational Isomers:** - same molecule that only differ in 3D shape due to free rotation around single bonds
- Enantiomers:** - non-superimposable mirror images that share physical & chemical properties in achiral environment
- Diastereomers:** - non-superimposable, non-mirror images that have different physical & chemical properties
- Meso Compounds:** - non-chiral due to the plane of symmetry, however, have chiral centers



Stereochemical Relationships of Enantiomers

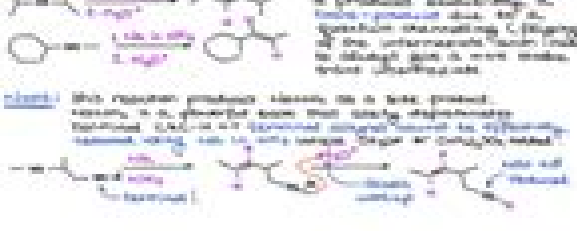
Enantiomers are mirror images that are non-superimposable. They have identical physical properties in an achiral environment, but differ in their interaction with plane-polarized light (optical activity) and in their chemical reactivity with chiral reagents.

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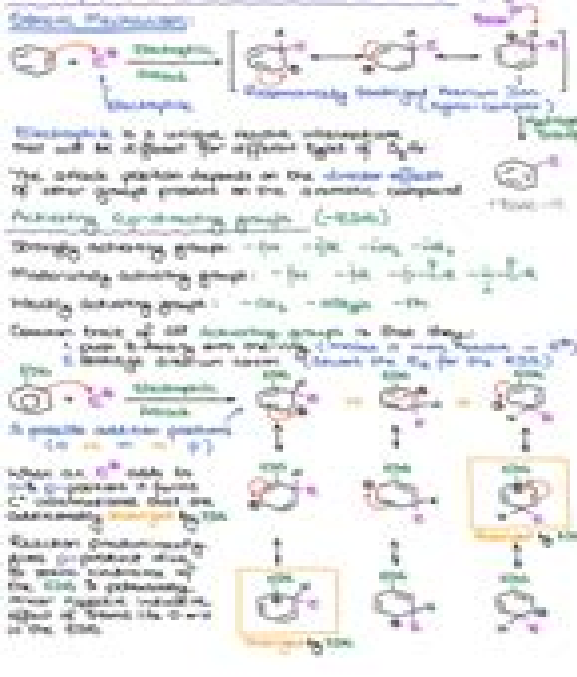
Reaction of Aldehydes with Nucleophiles in Liquid Phase



Reaction of Aldehydes with Nucleophiles in Solid Phase

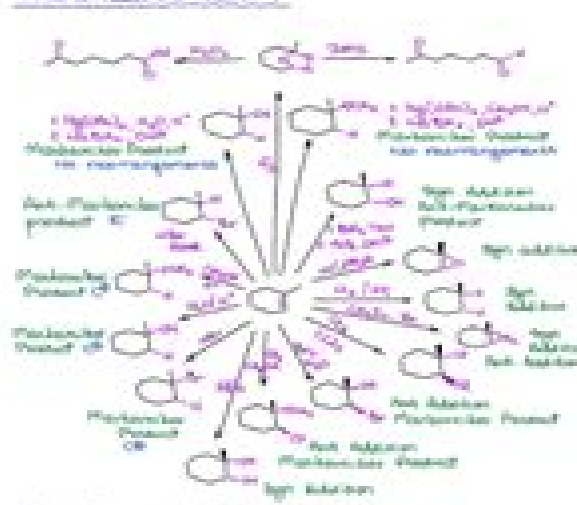


Electrophilic Addition, Substitution Reactions



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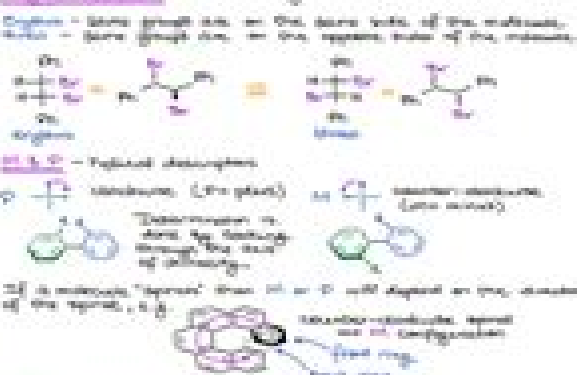
Alkene Reaction Mechanism
