Orazio and Artemisia Gentileschi Keith Christiansen, Judith W. Mann, 2013-12 This beautifully produced volume brings together for the first time works by two remarkable painters of seventeenth century Italy who happen also to have been father and daughter Orazio and Artemisia Gentileschi Famous in their own day these two artists have enjoyed renewed fame in the twentieth century Orazio as one of the first and certainly the most individual of Caravaggio's followers Artemisia as the outstanding female painter prior to the twentieth century The tumultuous lives of these two artists moved along parallel trajectories and take the reader from the popular quarters of papal Rome and the rough and tumble world of Naples to the courts of the grand duke of Tuscany Marie de Medici in Paris and Charles I in London These changing circumstances nourished two different aesthetic visions both of which were deeply rooted in the Caravaggesque practice of painting directly from the posed model While Orazio's art became every more refined and elegant Artemisia espoused a rhetorical form of dramatic presentation that is the basis of Baroque painting Written to accompany the landmark exhibition held in Rome New York and Saint Louis the book includes essays that describe the art and people the two painters encountered in the course of their peripatetic careers and address such issues as feminism and the critical interpretation of Artemisia's work The essays arranged chronologically to follow the artists as they moved from city to city not only provide critical commentary but illuminate the historical context in which they worked The appendices include previously unpublished documents relating to the trial of Orazio's colleague Agostino Tassi for his rape of Artemisia which shed new light on her father's workshop practice and a recently discovered inventory of Artemisia's household goods drawn up on the eve of her departure from Florence to Rome The book is the work of Keith Christiansen and Judith W Mann with contributions by a team of outstanding scholars This book was originally published in 2001 and has gone out of print This edition is a print on demand version of the original book *Orazio E Artemisia Gentileschi*, 2001 **Orazio and Artemisia Gentileschi** Cristina Terzaghi, 2017 A

fundamental study on two central representatives of the Caravaggesque style which flourished in Italian art of the 17th century Sheds new light on Orazio's sojourn to Paris a subject on which little has been written Contains new additions to the catalogue of works painted by Artemisia Gentileschi while in London and analysis of previously unpublished documents and correspondence In 1624 Orazio Gentileschi 1563-1639 left Italy for Paris where he had been summoned by the Queen Maria de Medici Two years later he moved to London to work for the Duke of Buckingham and after the Duke's assassination for

Charles I and his wife Queen Henrietta Maria Orazio died in London in 1639 while his daughter Artemisia who had joined him in 1638 remained in Britain till 1640 But these simple biographical facts do not do these great artists justice A dozen stunning paintings and a number of documents several of them previously unpublished are all the remaining evidence that illuminates this period of the Gentileschi's personal lives In this book the Gentileschi's work is placed in the context of courtly patronage a structure in which art and politics were strictly intertwined Charles I was attempting to transform his court into a truly European one art collections included while papal diplomacy worked tirelessly to convert Charles so that he might join the ranks of Catholic monarchs Art was instrumental to this attempt Cardinal Francesco Barberini on behalf of pope Urbano VIII sent many artworks to the court of St James Evidently art's function extended beyond the aesthetic Paying tribute to art's prime position within the monarchic establishment of 17th century Europe this book will be an invaluable resource for any student of Art History

Abstract: Artemisia Gentileschi gilt als die wohl erfolgreichste Künstlerin des Barocks und war die erste Frau in der westlichen Geschichte, die das Konzept des Künstlergenies erfüllte. Nach ihrem Tod geriet sie für fast 350 Jahre in Vergessenheit. Bis Roberto Longhi 1916 maßgeblich zu ihrer Wiederentdeckung beitrug und sie als einzige Frau in Italien, die jemals wusste, was Malerei, Kolorit und Farbauftrag ist, priest. with the majority representing the sixteenth century Approximately one third of the selections are well known letters such as those of Catherine of Siena Veronica Franco and Isabella d Este the rest are lesser known previously un translated or otherwise inaccessible

The Matter of Violence in Baroque Painting Bogdan Cornea,2025-10-01 Baroque depictions of violence are often dismissed as over the top and excessive Their material richness and exciting visual complexity together with the visceral engagement they demand from beholders are usually explained in literature as reflecting the presumed violence of early modern society This book explores the intersection between materiality excess and violence in seventeenth century paintings through a close analysis of some of the most iconic works of the period Baroque paintings expose or reference their materiality by insisting on various physical changes wrought through violence This study approaches violence as the work of materiality which has the potential to analogously stage pictorial surfaces as corporeal surfaces where paint becomes flayed flesh canvas threads ruptured skin and red paint spilt blood

Old Masters in New Colours Farkaš Patrik,Zapletalová Jana,2024 The study of the artworks of the Old Masters has long been the prerogative of art historians alone Expertise and other art historical methods can now make much greater use than ever before of the findings of the so called exact sciences These make it possible to acquire new knowledge about works of art of the past that is not obvious to our eyes Imaging and instrumental methods for the study of works of art often allow us to literally look into the painting below the surface of what we see and observe the work in different areas of the invisible spectrum of electromagnetic radiation for example By using various research methods with the necessary caution and awareness of their limitations it is often possible to gain insight into the hypothetical process of the creation of the work and into the painting s layers It is possible to characterize the material nature or technological processes or to study the author s changes and later interventions in the work Various research methods allow us to see artworks from different perspectives and to study them figuratively speaking in new colours often the colours in which they appear to our eyes using a variety of imaging methods How an art historian can work with technological knowledge and to what extent he can rely on it at all is demonstrated and
