Lab 1 - Melting Point

Part I - Purpose and Procedure

The purpose of the lab is determine the melting point of samples of pure urea, pure cinnamic acid, and varying mixtures of the two.

Procedure

Melting Points of Pure Urea and Cinnamic Acid

- 1. Crush a sample of both pure urea and cinnamic acid into powder using a metal spatula
- Push the open end of a capillary into the powder in order to force the powder into the capillary, then lightly tap the capillary on a hard surface until the sample is tightly packed at the bottom
- Heat the melting point system to approximately fifteen degrees below the known melting point should be the same for both the urea and the cinnamic acid
- 4. Heat samples at the rate of one degree per minute
- Note the temperature at which the first drops of liquid appear
- 6. Note the temperature at which any trace of solid has disappeared

Melting Points of Urea-Cinnamic Acid Mixtures

- 1. Make mixtures of urea and cinnamic acid in the approximate proportions 1:4, 1:1, and 4:1
- 2. Grind mixtures to ensure thoroughly mixed
- 3. Refer to the steps of the previous procedure for the remainder
