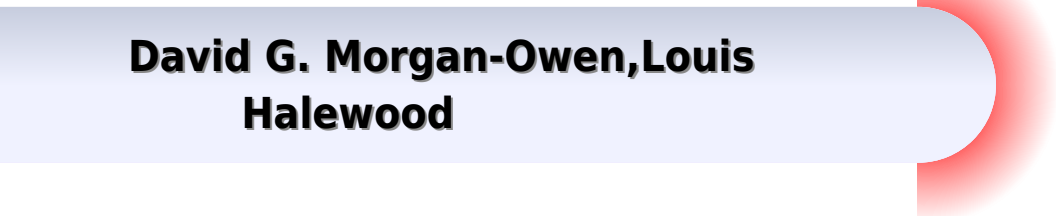

Methods in World History Janken Myrdal, Arne Jarrick, Maria Wallenberg Bondesson, 2016-05-02 Methods in World History is the first international volume that systematically addresses a number of methodological problems specific to the field of world history Prompted by a lack of applicable works the authors advocate a considerable sharpening of the tools used within the field of study Theories constructed on poor foundations run an obvious risk of reinforcing flawed assumptions and of propping up other more ideological constructions The dedicated critical approach outlined in this volume helps to mitigate such risks Each author addresses a particular issue of method for source criticism archaeological evidence or estimates of economies for example discussing the problems giving practical examples and offering solutions and ways of overcoming the difficulties involved The perspectives are varied the criticism focussed and a common theme of coalescence is maintained throughout This unique anthology will be of great use to advanced scholars of world history and to students entering the field for the first time

Quantitative Approaches to Medieval Swedish Law Fredrik Charpentier Ljungqvist, 2022-02-08 This book presents a novel framework for studying historical legalisation using quantitative methods with 10 fully preserved laws from medieval Sweden written between c 1225 and 1350 serving as a case study By applying a

systematic classification scheme to each legal provision it is possible to investigate the major differences and similarities in structure and content between the 10 laws This in turn allows for the re assessment of many long standing problems in Swedish and European medieval legal history that have been challenging to address with traditional methods based on text analyses Over the course of the thirteenth and fourteenth centuries major changes in the proportion of legal provisions devoted to different fields of law and to prescribed consequences are found The book shows how the proportions of civil law and public law expanded at the expense of criminal law Furthermore a clear transition from casuistic to more abstract law provisions can also be witnessed Historical Dictionaries in their Paratextual Context Roderick McConchie,Jukka

War 1618-1648 Olli Bäckström,2023-11-08 Military Revolution and the Thirty Years War 1618 1648 investigates change and decline in military institutions during a period of protracted and destructive European warfare Conceptual background is provided by the Military Revolution thesis which argues that changes in military technology and tactics drove revolutionary transformation in the way states organised and waged war in the early modern era This transformation of military

institutions became evident during the long and destructive Thirty Years War in 1618-1648. The outcome of the Military Revolution was the centralised fiscal military state that possessed a strong claim to the monopoly of violence within its territorial boundaries. The book examines how the Thirty Years War accelerated and even initiated transformation in four military institutions that defined land warfare: feudal cavalry, services, militias, regular armies, and war commissariats. The regional scope of the investigation covers the Holy Roman Empire, France, Spain, Portugal, Sweden, Denmark, and the Dutch Republic. The book combines military historical inquiry with ancillary sciences of sociology and economics. It argues that the Military Revolution of the Thirty Years War stimulated institutions capable of increased complexification and specialisation while curtailing those that were locked in stasis and immutability. The institutional legacy of the Thirty Years War was the emergence of complex military organisations that are characteristic to the modern society and its self-renewing social subsystems. Previous scholarship on the Military Revolution has concentrated on military technicalities and the wider process of early modern state formation. This book proposes an alternative way of viewing early modern military transformations from the perspectives of institutions and systems. System analytical survey of change and decline in the military institutions of the Thirty Years War introduces qualifications to the Military Revolution theory and offers a novel way of conceptualising early modern military history.

Dutch Warships in the Age of Sail, 1600-1714 James Bender, 2014-12-01. This definitive study presents a complete account of the Dutch Republic's naval fleet during its golden age as a world power. The Netherlands was by far the most important maritime power of the seventeenth century. It dominated seaborne trade with the largest merchant fleet in the world. Born out of an 80-year struggle against Spain for independence, the Dutch republic relied on naval power to protect its freedom, promote its trade, and defend its overseas colonies. Yet the ships that made up its fleets are among the least studied of any in the age of sail. This is partly because a decentralized administration of five separate admiralties often producing ships of the same name at the same time, as well as competing systems of measuring ships, all lead to confusion and error. In this comprehensive volume, James Bender delivers the first definitive listing of all Dutch fighting ships, whether purpose-built, purchased, hired, or captured from the heyday of the United Provinces. Each entry is complete with technical details and summaries of the ship's career. It also provides administrative, economic, and technical background and outlines the many campaigns fought by one of the most successful navies in history.

The Story of War Anna Maria Forssberg, 2017-03-15. O God, we thank thee was sung in the churches of France and Sweden after military victories in the seventeenth century. To celebrate Thanksgiving was a way of thanking God but also a way for the rulers to legitimize the ever-ongoing wars. For the inhabitants, it was both an occasion for festivity and a way of getting information about what happened in the battlefield. Yet the image given was selective. Bloody defeats and uneventful everyday life were replaced by spectacular victories and royal glory. Even though the rituals in the two countries were similar in some ways, there were also substantial differences. The propaganda formulated a narrative about what war actually was and what role the rulers and their subjects

should play In the crisis of 1709 this narrative was profoundly challenged The book investigates how war events were communicated to the inhabitants of France and Sweden in the seventeenth century by the Church and especially through days of thanksgiving called Te Deum in France

Civilians and Military Supply in Early Modern Finland Petri Talvitie, Juha-Matti Granqvist, 2021-06-22 During the early modern centuries gunpowder and artillery revolutionized warfare and armies grew rapidly To sustain their new military machines the European rulers turned increasingly to their civilian subjects making all levels of civil society serve the needs of the military This volume examines civil military interaction in the multinational Swedish Realm in 1550 1800 with a focus on its eastern part present day Finland which was an important supply region and battlefield bordered by Russia Sweden was one of the frontrunners of the Military Revolution in the 16th and 17th centuries The crown was eager to adapt European models but its attempts to outsource military supply to civilians in a realm lacking people capital and resources were not always successful This book aims at explaining how the army utilized civilians burghers peasants entrepreneurs to provision itself and how the civil population managed to benefit from the cooperation The chapters of the book illustrate the different ways in which Finnish civilians took part in supplying war efforts e g how the army made deals with businessmen to finance its military campaigns and how town and country people were obliged to lodge and feed soldiers The European armies dependence on civilian maintenance has received growing scholarly attention in recent years and *Civilians and Military Supply in Early Modern Finland* brings a Nordic perspective to the debate

Reward and Punishment in Social Dilemmas Paul A.M. Van Lange, Bettina Rockenbach, Toshio Yamagishi, 2014-03-18 One of the key scientific challenges is the puzzle of human cooperation Why do people cooperate Why do people help strangers even sometimes at a major cost to themselves Why do people want to punish others who violate norms and undermine collective interests Reward and punishment is a classic theme in research on social dilemmas More recently it has received considerable attention from scientists working in various disciplines such as economics neuroscience and psychology We know now that reward and punishment can promote cooperation in so called public good dilemmas where people need to decide how much from their personal resources to contribute to the public good Clearly enjoying the contributions of others while not contributing is tempting Punishment and reward are effective in reducing free riding Yet the recent explosion of research has also triggered many questions For example who can reward and punish most effectively Is punishment effective in any culture What are the emotions that accompany reward and punishment Even if reward and punishment are effective are they also efficient knowing that rewards and punishment are costly to administer How can sanctioning systems best organized to be reduce free riding The chapters in this book the first in a series on human cooperation explore the workings of reward and punishment how they should be organized and their functions in society thereby providing a synthesis of the psychology economics and neuroscience of human cooperation

Niederländische Seefahrer in schwedischen Diensten Hielke van Nieuwenhuize, 2022-01-17 Die Expansion der schwedischen Schifffahrt um

1650 wurde ohne niederländischer Beteiligung undenkbar gewesen. Obwohl die Ausrüstung einer ganzen Flotte misslang, fand dank der Migration von niederländischen Seefahrern ein Transfer von seemännischen Fähigkeiten und Kenntnissen nach Schweden statt. Von 1630 bis 1660 rekrutierte die schwedische Admiralität etwa 200 niederländische Offiziere und Steuerleute. Während der Expansion der schwedischen Schifffahrt navigierten diese Niederländer die Schiffe der Marine und Handelskompanien durch die unbekannten Gewässer außerhalb der Ostsee. Hierbei lernte eine neue Generation von schwedischen Offizieren die Kunst und Fertigkeiten der niederländischen Seeschifffahrt. Leider blieb der Erfolg der niederländischen Hilfsflotte für Schweden während des Torstenssonkriegs 1643/1645 aus. Trotz großer diplomatischer Anstrengungen blieb die Flotte schwach ausgerüstet. Die Schiffe waren teuer und ihre Bewaffnung mangelhaft. Um die Flotte finanzieren zu können und die Loyalität der Matrosen zu garantieren, war man gezwungen, sich auf die Kaperei zu konzentrieren. Zudem standen die finanziellen Interessen des Kriegsunternehmers und die staatlichen schwedischen Interessen im Widerspruch zueinander und förderten das Risiko von Meutereien.

History of Law and Other Humanities. Views of the legal world across the time Valerio Massimo Minale, Virginia Amorosi, 2019-07-09. The collection of essays presented here examines the links forged through the ages between the realm of law and the expressions of the humanistic culture. We collected thirty-five essays by international scholars and organized them into sections of ten chapters based around ten different themes. Two main perspectives emerged in some articles: the topic relates to the conventional approach of law and in humanities iconography, literature, architecture, cinema, music. Other articles are about more traditional connections between fields of knowledge in particular philosophy, political experiences, didactics. We decided not to confine authors to one particular methodological framework, preferring instead to promote historiographical openness. Our intention was to create a patchwork of different approaches, with each article drawing on a different area of culture to provide a new angle to the history being told. The variety of authorial nationalities gives the collection a multicultural character, and the breadth of the chronological period it deals with, from antiquity to the contemporary age, adds further depth of insight. As the element that unites the collection is historiographical interpretation, we wanted to bring to the fore its historical depth. Thus, for every chapter, we organized the articles in chronological order according to the historical context covered. Looking at the final outcome, it was interesting to learn that more often than not, the connection between law and humanities is not simply a relation between a specific branch of the law and a single field of the humanities, but rather a relation that could be developed in many directions at once, involving different fields of knowledge and of arts and popular culture. We are grateful to Luigi Lacchè for his contribution to this collection. His essay outlines the coordinates of the law and humanities world, laying out the instruments necessary for an understanding of the origins of a complex methodology and the different approaches that exist within it. This project is the result of discussions that took place during the XXIII Forum of the Association of Young Legal Historians held in Naples in the spring of 2017.
