The Material Culture of English Rural Households c. 1250-1600 Ben Jervis, Chris Briggs, Alice Forward, Tomasz Gromelski, Matthew Tompkins, 2023-09-20 This book presents a synthesis and analysis of the possessions of non elite rural households in medieval England Drawing on the results of the Leverhulme Trust funded project Living Standards and Material Culture in English Rural Households 1300 1600 it represents the first national scale interdisciplinary analysis of non elite consumption in the later Middle Ages The research is situated within debates around rising living standards in the period following the Black Death the commercialisation of the English economy and the timing of a revolution in consumer behaviour Its novelty derives from its focus on non elite rural households Whilst there has been considerable work on the possessions of the great households and those living in larger towns researchers have struggled to identify appropriate sources for understanding the possessions of those living in the countryside even though they account for the majority of England's population at this time This book will address the gap in understanding The study combines 3 sources of data to address 2 questions what goods did medieval households own and what influenced their consumption habits The first is archaeological evidence comprising 14 706 objects recovered from archaeological excavations The book synthesises this data much of which is unpublished and therefore inaccessible to researchers The second dataset derives from lists of the seized goods of felons outlaws and suicides collated by the Escheator a royal official in the 14th and 15th centuries The work of the Escheator is not well understood but these lists relating to some of the poorest people in medieval society for whom traditional sources such as wills and probate inventories do not exist provide new insights into the living standards of rural households The lists typically detail and value the possessions of a household meaning that it is possible to present a quantitative analysis of non elite consumption for the first time The final dataset draws on equivalent lists generated by the Coroner for the 16th century An interdisciplinary approach is essential as many objects identified archaeologically do not occur in the written records and goods such as textiles do not survive in the ground Drawing these sources together therefore allows the presentation of a more comprehensive analysis of the possessions of medieval households The introduction lays out the research context in a manner accessible to historians and archaeologists who may not be familiar with work in each other's disciplines This is followed by a brief summary of the

research methodology and the sources underpinning the research The next 5 chapters focus on addressing the question of what medieval households owned discussing the evidence for kitchen equipment tableware furniture clothing and personal items The following 3 chapters discuss household economy considering the evidence for the production of goods variation in consumption between town and country and variation in accordance with wealth firstly through the consideration of these themes at the national scale and secondly through a regional case study focussed on Wiltshire which has particularly rich archaeological and documentary sources The volume closes with a concluding chapter which places the research back into its wider context

The Archaeology of the Lower City and Adjacent Suburbs Jenny Mann,Alan Vince,Jane Young,2016-04-30 This volume contains reports on excavations undertaken in the lower walled city at Lincoln which lies on sloping ground on the northern scarp of the Witham gap and its adjacent suburbs between 1972 and 1987 and forms a companion volume to LAS volumes 2 and 3 which cover other parts of the historic city The earliest features encountered were discovered both near to the line of Ermine Street and towards Broadgate Remains of timber storage buildings were found probably associated with the Roman legionary occupation in the later 1st century AD The earliest occupation of the hillside after the foundation of the colonia towards the end of the century consisted mainly of commercial premises modest residences and storage buildings It seems likely that the boundary of the lower enclosure was designated before it was fortified in the later 2nd century with the street pattern belonging to the earlier part of the century Larger aristocratic residences came to dominate the hillside with public facilities fronting on to the line of the zigzagging main route In the 4th century the fortifications were enlarged and two new gates inserted Examples of so called Dark Earth deposits were here dated to the very latest phases of Roman occupation Elements of some Roman structures survived to be reused in subsequent centuries There are hints of one focus in the Middle Saxon period in the area of St Peter s church but occupation of an urban nature did not recommence until the late

9th century with the first phases of Anglo Scandinavian occupation recorded here Sequences of increasingly intensive occupation from the 10th century were identified with plentiful evidence for industrial activity including pottery metalworking and other crafts as well as parish churches Markets were established in the 11th century and stone began to replace timber for residential structures from the mid 12th century with clear evidence of the quality of some of the houses With the decline in the city s fortunes from the late 13th century the fringe sites became depopulated and there was much rebuilding elsewhere including some fine new houses There was a further revival in the later post medieval period but much of the earlier fabric and surviving stretches of Roman city wall were swept away in the 19th century **Deserted Villages Revisited** Christopher Dyer,Richard Jones,2010 Assembling leading experts on the subject this account explores the circumstances surrounding the disappearance of thousands of villages and smaller settlements in England and Wales between 1340 and 1750 By revisiting the deserted villages this breakthrough study addresses questions that have plagued archaeologists geographers and historians since the 1940s including why they were deserted why some villages survived while others were abandoned and who was responsible for their desertion offering a series of exciting insights into the fate of these fascinating sites **Stratton, Biggleswade: 1,300 Years of Village Life in Eastern Bedfordshire from the 5th Century AD** Drew Shotliff,David Ingham,2022-04-28 Presents the results of 12 hectares of archaeological excavation undertaken between 1990 2001 As well as uncovering roughly half of the medieval village the investigations revealed that Stratton s origins stretched back to the early Anglo Saxon period with the settlement remaining in continuous use through to c 1700 **Jahrbuch des Römisch-Germanischen Zentralmuseums Mainz** Römisch-Germanisches Zentralmuseum Mainz,2003 *Medieval Adaptation, Settlement and Economy of a Coastal Wetland* Luke Barber,Greg Priestley-Bell,2008 Romney Marsh is the largest coastal lowland on the south coast of England Since 1991 excavations in advance of gravel extraction around Lydd on Romney Marsh have uncovered large areas of medieval landscape one of the largest to be exposed in southern England Features uncovered include 12th 13th century drainage ditches ditched field systems and sea defences Also of particular significance is the identification of a series of occupation sites and their enclosures The excavation of dispersed settlements is particularly difficult because of the scale of work required to produce meaningful results In this case it has been possible to work on sufficiently large areas to allow significant conclusions to be drawn The excavations at Lydd Quarry have shown how dispersed settlement existed alongside the nucleated market settlements on Romney Marsh This extensive report details the archaeological investigations of the field systems and occupation sites finds and environmental material There is also a section by Sheila Sweetinburgh on the documentary evidence Two final chapters set out broader conclusions from the evidence for the field systems settlements and economy and set the area in its wider context The research has provided an unprecedented opportunity to study reclamation occupation and economy of a large tract of marginal landscape through a considerable period of time Current Archaeology ,2002 *British National Bibliography*

Saunders,2006 This monograph focuses on Launceston Castle which occupies a dominating position at the end of a ridge commanding the strategic crossing of the River Tamar separating Cornwall from Devon It includes contributions by Umberto Albarella F W Anderson Duncan Brown John A Davies Simon J M Davis David Dungworth Geoff Egan D A Higgins Carole A Keepax S A Mays J G McDonnell Quita Mould R L Otlett Ian Riddler Kate Steane Robert Thompson Rachel Tyson Alan Vince and David Williams Excavations at Dryslwyn Castle, 1980-95 Chris Caple,2007 Excavations at Dryslwyn between 1980 and 1995 uncovered a masonry castle founded in the late 1220s by Rhys Gryg for his son Maredudd ap Rhys the first Lord of Dryslwyn The first castle was a simple round tower and polygonal walled enclosure within which were constructed a kitchen prison and wood framed clay floored great chamber beside a great hall In the mid 13th century a second ward was added and the great chamber rebuilt in stone This castle was greatly expanded in the period 1283-87 by Rhys ap Maredudd the second and final Lord of Dryslwyn who built an Outer Ward and gatehouse He also rebuilt much of the Inner Ward adding an extra storey to the great hall and great chamber apartments and a chapel At the end of the 13th century a large three ward castle stretched along the eastern and southern edge of the hill while the rest of the hilltop was occupied by a settlement defended by a wall and substantial ditch with access through a gatehouse This castle and its associated settlement were besieged and captured in 1287 by an English royal army of over 11 000 men following damage inflicted by a trebuchet and mining of the walls Throughout the 14th century the English Crown garrisoned and repaired the castle supervised by an appointed constable before it was surrendered to Owain Glyn Dwr in 1403 During the early to mid 15th century the castle was deliberately walled up to deny its use to a potential enemy and it was subsequently looted and demolished By the late 13th century the castle had a white rendered and lime washed appearance creating a very dramatic and highly visible symbol of lordship Internally the lord's and guest apartments had decorative wall paintings and glazed windows Evidence from charred beams still in situ the sizes shapes and distribution of nails sheet lead slates and postholes recovered during excavation has enabled some of the wooden as well as masonry buildings to be reconstructed Waterlogged deposits had preserved At just 132 hectares 325 acres the parish of Caldecote is one of the smallest parishes in Hertfordshire Today the settlement comprises the manor house until recently surrounded by a range of traditional farm buildings together with six labourer's cottages and the church To the north lies the site of the old rectory and the earthworks of a medieval settlement In 1973 the Department of Environment and the Deserted Medieval Village Research Group arranged a rescue excavation to examine the earthworks of the medieval village before they were levelled and ploughed Five crofts the old rectory site and much of the moated enclosure were investigated in one of the largest excavations ever conducted on a later medieval rural site in Britain Though the excavations did recover a Bronze Age beaker burial and small quantities of Roman and Iron Age pottery the medieval settlement at Caldecote was probably founded in the 10th century and by the time of the Domesday Survey there was a church a priest and nine villeins A
