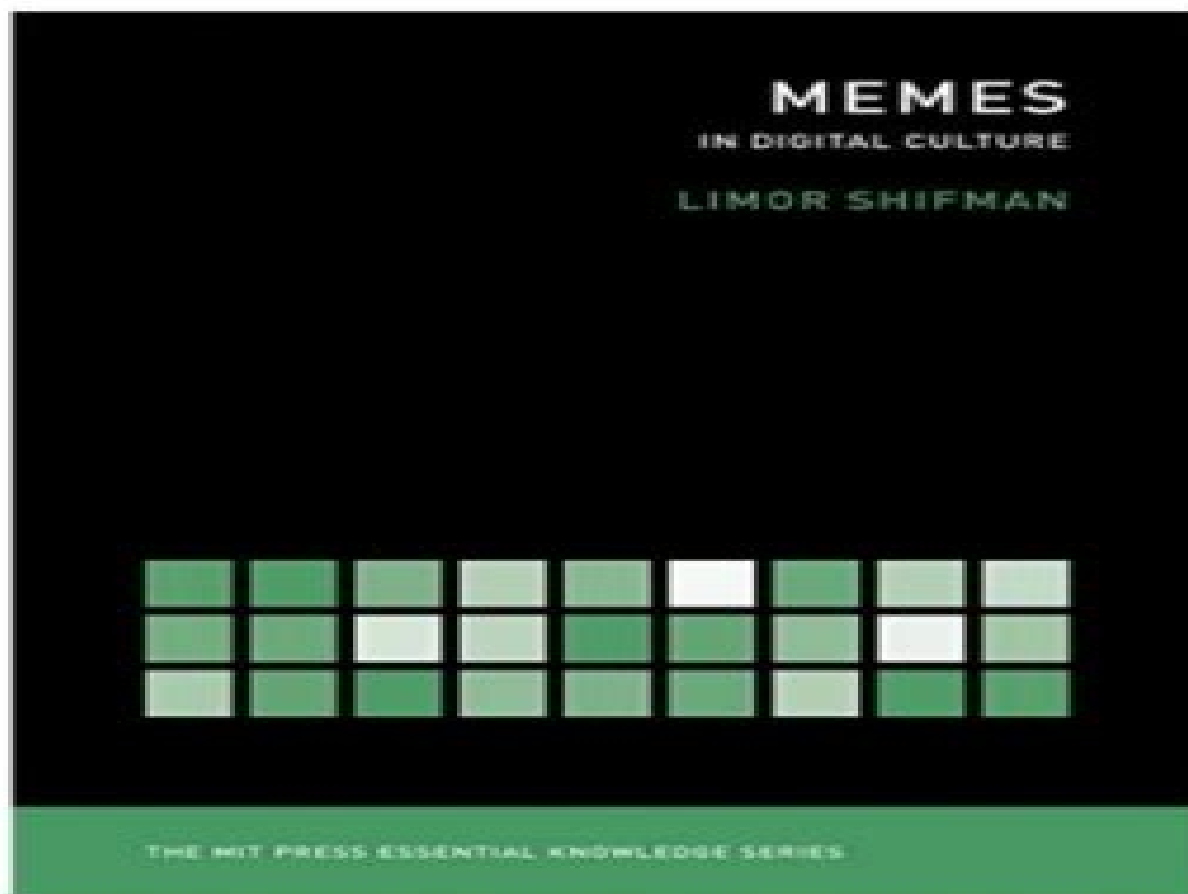

**Quantum Entanglement** Jed Brody, 2020-02-18 A concise non technical exploration of quantum entanglement the enigma Albert Einstein called spooky action at a distance and how it contradicts our assumptions about the ultimate nature of reality Quantum physics is notable for its brazen defiance of common sense Think of Schrödinger's Cat famously both dead and alive An especially rigorous form of quantum contradiction occurs in experiments with entangled particles Our common assumption is that objects have properties whether or not anyone is observing them and the measurement of one can't affect the other Quantum entanglement called by Einstein spooky action at a distance rejects this assumption offering impeccable reasoning and irrefutable evidence of the opposite Is quantum entanglement mystical or just mystifying In this volume in the MIT Press Essential Knowledge series Jed Brody equips readers to decide for themselves He explains how our commonsense assumptions impose constraints from which entangled particles break free Brody explores such concepts as local realism Bell's inequality polarization time dilation and special relativity He introduces readers to imaginary physicists Alice and Bob and their photon analyses points out that it's easier to reject falsehood than establish the truth and reports that some physicists explain entanglement by arguing that we live in a cross section of a higher dimensional reality He examines a variety of viewpoints held by physicists including quantum decoherence Niels Bohr's Copenhagen interpretation genuine fortuitousness and QBism This relatively recent interpretation an abbreviation of

quantum Bayesianism holds that there's no such thing as an absolutely accurate objective probability out there that quantum mechanical probabilities are subjective judgments and there's no action at a distance spooky or otherwise

Irony and Sarcasm Roger Kreuz, 2020-02-18 A psycholinguist explores the use and misuse of the words irony and sarcasm throughout history Isn't it ironic Or is it Never mind I'm just being sarcastic or am I Irony and sarcasm are two of the most misused misapplied and misunderstood words in our conversational lexicon In this volume in the MIT Press Essential Knowledge series psycholinguist Roger Kreuz offers an enlightening and concise overview of the life and times of these two terms mapping their evolution from Greek philosophy and Roman rhetoric to modern literary criticism to emojis Kreuz describes 8 different ways that irony has been used through the centuries proceeding from Socratic to dramatic to cosmic irony He explains that verbal irony irony as it is traditionally understood refers to statements that mean something different frequently the opposite of what is literally intended and defines sarcasm as a type of verbal irony Kreuz outlines the prerequisites for irony and sarcasm one of which is a shared frame of reference clarifies what irony is not coincidence paradox satire and what it can be among other things a socially acceptable way to express hostility recounts ways that people can signal their ironic intentions and considers the difficulties of online irony Finally he wonders if because irony refers to so many different phenomena people may gradually stop using the word with sarcasm taking over its verbal duties

**3D Printing** John M. Jordan, 2019-03-12 An accessible introduction to 3D printing that outlines the additive manufacturing process industrial and household markets and emerging uses The use of 3D printing digitally controlled additive manufacturing is growing rapidly Consumer models of 3D printers allow people to fabricate small plastic objects from cabinet knobs to wedding cake toppers Industrial uses are becoming widespread as businesses use the technology to fabricate prototypes spare parts custom fitted prosthetics and other plastic or metal items often at lower cost

Contraception Donna J. Drucker, 2020-04-07 The development manufacturing and use of contraceptive methods from the late nineteenth century to the present viewed from the perspective of reproductive justice The beginning of the modern contraceptive era began in 1882 when Dr Aletta Jacobs opened the first birth control clinic in Amsterdam The founding of this facility and the clinical provision of contraception that it enabled marked the moment when physicians started to take the prevention of pregnancy seriously as a medical concern In this volume in the MIT Press Essential Knowledge series Donna Drucker traces the history of modern contraception outlining the development manufacturing and use of contraceptive methods from the opening of Dr Jacobs s clinic to the present Drucker approaches the subject from the perspective of reproductive justice the right to have a child the right not to have a child and the right to parent children safely and healthily Drucker describes contraceptive methods available before the pill including the diaphragm dispensed at the Jacobs clinic and condom spermicidal jellies and periodic abstinences She looks at the development and dissemination of the pill and its chemical descendants describes technological developments in such non hormonal contraceptives as the cervical cap and timing methods including the rhythm method favored by the Roman Catholic church and explains the concept of reproductive justice Finally Drucker considers the future of contraception the adaptations of existing methods new forms of distribution and ongoing efforts needed to support contraceptive access worldwide

*Fake Photos* Hany Farid, 2019-09-10 A concise and accessible guide to techniques for detecting doctored and fake images in photographs and digital media Stalin Mao Hitler Mussolini and other dictators routinely doctored photographs so that the images aligned with their messages They erased people who were there added people who were not and manipulated backgrounds They knew if they changed the visual record they could change history Once altering images required hours in the darkroom today it can be done with a keyboard and mouse Because photographs are so easily faked fake photos are everywhere supermarket tabloids fashion magazines political ads and social media How can we tell if an image is real or false
