Santa Ana in Vintage Postcards Guy Ball, 2001 Santa Ana began as the dream of early pioneers in the 1800s when the dry desolate area was little more than windswept fields of wild mustard grass Santa Ana celebrates this area's pioneer heritage and the people who created it and chronicles the development of this city with fascinating vintage postcards Santa Ana was one of the earliest incorporated cities and became the county seat in 1889 Wealthy businessmen successful political leaders and even an occasional maharajah chose Santa Ana as their home Today Orange County is one of the most dynamic counties in California

Vietnamese in Orange County Thuy Vo Dang, Linda Trinh Vo, Tram Le, 2015-03-09 Vietnamese Americans have transformed the social cultural economic and political life of Orange County California Previously there were Vietnamese international students international or war brides or military personnel living in the United States but the majority arrived as refugees and immigrants after the end of the Vietnam War in 1975 Although they are lumped together as refugees Vietnamese Americans are diverse in terms of their class ethnic regional religious linguistic and ideological backgrounds Their migration path varied and they often struggled with resettling in a new homeland and rebuilding their lives They are dispersed throughout the country but many are concentrated in central Orange County where three cities Westminster Garden Grove and Santa Ana have Welcome to Little Saigon signs They constitute the largest population of Vietnamese outside of Vietnam and have created flourishing residential neighborhoods and bustling commercial centers and contribute to the political and cultural life of the region This book captures snapshots of Vietnamese life in Orange County over the span of 40 years and shows a dynamic vibrant community that is revitalizing the region

Inland Empire John Howard Weeks, 2008 Southern California's vast Inland Empire is one of the fastest growing regions of the United States It is a wonderland of old growth vineyards citrus groves hot water resorts Wild West landmarks and Native American territories America's fabled Mother Road Route 66 runs right through it Its fertile valleys are encircled by mountains with famous resort areas such as Idyllwild Big Bear Lake and Lake Arrowhead Those mountains are surrounded in turn by some of the world's best known desert resort and recreational areas including Palm Springs the Mojave Death Valley and Joshua Tree National Park Inland Empire is the first book of its kind offering a postcard perfect grand tour of the entire region

Baseball in Orange County Chris Epting, 2012-06-11 Organized baseball in Orange County began in the late 1880s when community teams began forming among oil well workers Around 1900 a farm boy from Kansas named Walter Johnson arrived with his family Soon the flame throwing future hall of fame pitcher would be dominating games throughout the county as a star for Fullerton Union High School As the popularity of baseball grew more teams and leagues formed in Santa Ana Anaheim Huntington Beach and other cities Connie Mack brought the Philadelphia Athletics to spring train in Orange County in the 1940s Joe DiMaggio played for his Santa Ana Air Base team after joining the Army Babe Ruth Lou Gehrig Jackie Robinson and many other legends visited Orange County over the years Dozens of well known players grew up here and many are laid

to rest here In 1966 the California Angels played their first game in Orange County where they remain today as the Los Angeles Angels of Anaheim The baseball history in Orange County is rich and surprising *Vanishing Orange County* Chris Epting, 2008-11-10 Orange County formally separated from Los Angeles County in 1889 and there's been no looking back Wilderness gave way to rich farmlands where oranges lemons avocados and walnuts made agriculture the new county's most important industry the region was actually named for the prevalence of its citrus groves The 20th century brought with it plenty of entrepreneurs including Walter Knott and later Walt Disney along with the aerospace industry oil drilling beach culture and more But the more popular the O C became the more the past began to be lost to development and sprawl This evocative compendium of photographs revisits many of the places locals held near and dear including the Golden Bear nightclub Japanese Village Deer Park Lion Country Safari plus popular stores restaurants and of course the ever shrinking farmlands Many of these images are courtesy of the Orange County Archives and others came from the author's private collection *Orange County*, 2005 The formerly wide open space southeast of Los Angeles blossomed from cattle ranches into a center of citrus production by the early 20th century Orange County separated from Los Angeles County in 1889 soon Anaheim and Santa Ana changed from farming communities to major cities while coastal communities grew beyond anyone's imagination One of the most populous counties in the United States today Orange County began in the mid 20th century to evolve from its bedroom community status to become an urban suburban region with its own identity This collection of vintage postcards follows the county's diverse development illustrating such spots as Disneyland and the area's world renowned beaches as well as remembering the pastoral origins industries unique buildings and cityscapes that have added dimension to its history **Vanishing Los Angeles County** Cory Stargel, Sarah Stargel, 2010 Home to more than 10 million people modern Los Angeles County bears little resemblance to the largely agricultural landscape dotted with small towns of just over a century ago Los Angeles County has surged forward on a path of phenomenal growth and constant transformation Over this course much of what was both famous and familiar to Angelenos 100 or even 50 years ago has been lost in the name of progress This collection of more than 200 vintage postcards explores a sampling of these vanishing sites including the once ubiquitous orange groves views from the early days of the county's towns yesteryear's famed attractions landmarks hotels and restaurants and scenes from the roadside era *Newport Beach's Balboa and Balboa Island* Jeff Delaney, 2007 The village of Balboa lies on the eastern half of a 4 mile long peninsula a natural barrier that protects the neighboring Balboa Island from Pacific storms Both the village and the island have constituted a sun soaked paradise for residents and vacationers from all over the world for more than a century Famous for luxury homes miles of beautiful sandy beaches and one of the largest pleasure harbors on the West Coast Balboa has enjoyed a colorful history filled with backroom gambling midnight deliveries during Prohibition and frequent visits from Hollywood's biggest stars Such legends as John Wayne James Cagney Errol Flynn Humphrey Bogart and Lauren Bacall spent many a day sailing Balboa's harbor and many nights enjoying

its justifiably famous nightlife of dance halls restaurants and clubs Balboa and Balboa Island represent all of the extremes perhaps best exemplified in the quaintness of today's city of Newport Beach an Orange County enclave where great wealth commingles with the carefree charm of a barefoot community

Mojave Desert John Howard Weeks, 2012 It is a desert like no other stretching from the eastern outskirts of Los Angeles across the width of Southern California and into parts of Arizona Nevada and Utah The Mojave Desert's attractions include Death Valley the Joshua Tree National Park the Mojave National Preserve Las Vegas Hoover Dam Lake Mead the Colorado River Palm Springs the Cabazon Dinosaurs Calico Ghost Town and dozens of Route 66 landmarks It is the most spectacular desert on Earth and it draws more tourists each year than all other deserts of the world combined Mojave Desert is the first book of its kind using rare and vintage postcards to provide a pictorial historical grand tour of this American wonderland

Early Santa Ana Marge Bitetti, Guy Ball, 2006 Located at the heart of Orange County Santa Ana has been the civic and community center as the OC grew and prospered Thirty three miles from Los Angeles and 12 miles from the Pacific Ocean the city was founded by William Spurgeon who in 1867 purchased just over 74 acres of what was once the Yorba family's Rancho Santiago de Santa Ana to start a new community This book revisits those formative years that left a rich history in architecture and culture laying the foundation for today's 350 000 city residents Santa Ana boasts two historic districts and 20 buildings on the National Register of Historic Places Growing with the ranching and citrus industries as well as the transportation routes they spawned the city also contains 400 locations of historic significance on its own citywide historic register

West Orange Joseph Fagan, 2009 Although West Orange is best known for Thomas Edison there is much more to this New Jersey town than its famous inventor Through vintage postcards West Orange explores the town's history from the days of cable cars that once climbed the mountain to the long gone amusement park at Crystal Lake Postcards illustrate how Llewellyn Park and Eagle Rock share a common beginning and West Orange once had two train stations The familiar roads of home come alive as images reveal West Orange's rich history

Thunder on Bataan Donald L Caldwell, 2023-06-14 An incisive readable account of a group of National Guard tankers

who fought in the Philippines in the opening phase of America's war in the Pacific Robert S Cameron Ph D military historian and author of *Mobility Shock and Firepower The Emergence of the U S Army's Armor Branch 1917-1945* The American Provisional Tank Group had been in the Philippines only three weeks when the Japanese attacked the islands hours after the raid on Pearl Harbor Sent north to meet the Japanese landings in Lingayen Gulf the men of the PTG found themselves thrust into a critical role when the Philippine Army could not hold back the Japanese When General MacArthur ordered the retreat to Bataan the PTG proved itself indispensable During early months of 1942 the light tanks of the PTG patrolled Bataan's beaches encircling and destroying Japanese penetrations and small amphibious landings By April 1942 the situation had become untenable and 15 000 Americans along with 60 000 Filipinos surrendered in one of the worst defeats in U S military history The Provisional Tank Group ceased to exist and its men endured the Bataan Death March the torture and starvation of POW camps the hell ships that took them to Japan and Manchuria for slave labor and the Palawan massacre In an evocatively written book Donald L Caldwell reveals the largely ignored role of tanks in the Philippine campaign Conducting impressive primary research to bring to life the combat history of the PTG Caldwell has dug deeper to tell the stories of soldiers from each of the group's six companies recounting their service from enlistment training and combat to imprisonment liberation and return home Remarkable A well told history highly recommended Jay A Stout LtCol Ret USMC author of *Air Apaches* [Newsletter](#) Society for Historical Archaeology,1980 **Orange Coast Magazine** ,1991-09

Jenkins,2023-07-10 As Southern California recovered from the collapse of the cattle industry in the 1860s the arrival of railroads attacked by newspapers as the greedy octopus and the expansion of citrus agriculture transformed the struggling region into a vast idealized and prosperous garden New groves of the latest citrus varieties and new towns like Riverside quickly grew directly along the tracks of transcontinental railroads The influx of capital industrial technology and workers especially people of color energized Southern California and tied it more closely to the economy and culture of the United States than ever before Benjamin Jenkins's *Octopus's Garden* argues that citrus agriculture and railroads together shaped the economy landscape labor systems and popular image of Southern California Orange and lemon growing boomed in the 1870s and 1880s while railroads linked the region to markets across North America and ended centuries of geographic isolation for the West Coast Railroads competed over the shipment of citrus fruits from multiple counties engulfed by the orange empire resulting in an
