Sarah Voss, 1995-01-01 This book uses modern mathematical metaphors to better understand religion and philosophy **The Mystical Design of Paradise Lost** Galbraith Miller Crump, 1975 In investigating the mystic level of meaning implicit in Paradise Lost Professor Crump brings together for the first time those elements of style structure and content in Milton's epic that manifest this level of meaning and relates the poem to the long tradition of allegorical writing deriving from methods of biblical exegesis In Paradise Lost Milton created a vast hieroglyph of God's abundance and love and of man's response to them Adopting the traditional symbol of God as a point or circle the center and circumference of all things Milton fashioned his poem to embody that symbol in its smallest syntactical detail and in its largest structural design Thus he sought to make his poem consonant with what he believed to be the creative principal of the universe and to represent both the cyclical rhythms of man's world and the eternal immutable perfection of the Creator Milton sought to justify the ways of God to man literally by the narrative of the Creation Fall and promise of redemption Allegorically the story of the Fall might then be read as a type of the creation death and resurrection of Jesus the second Adam Morally the narrative illustrates the concept of the *felix culpa* the fortunate Fall and taught men the need to persevere in their faith in the knowledge that God continually brings good out of evil Anagogically the present study shows Paradise Lost expresses the numinous world of eternal life and implies how the cycles of change in the natural world shadow forth our sense of eternal return a sense that operates in us as it does in the epic below the threshold of consciousness In demonstrating the pervasiveness of a mystical that is anagogical level of meaning in Paradise Lost embodied structurally and the conceptually in the form of the circle Professor Crump first considers how the pattern impresses itself on the poem thematically and rhetorically Next he discusses how the overall design of the poem reflects the circular motif actually turning the epic into a giant figure poem Finally he considers the temporal design of this great epic showing how it too relates to the circular pattern by which Milton has fashioned one of the most elaborately wrought beautifully conceived and organized poems in the literature of Western man Galbraith Miller Crump War and Combat, 1150-1270 Catherine Hanley, 2003 An investigation of the depiction of warfare in contemporary writings in both fictional narratives and factual accounts **Chaucer and the Imagery of Narrative** V. Symbolic Scores Willem Elders, 2024-01-08 *Symbolic Scores* is the first monograph on Renaissance music devoted to discussing more than 150 compositions which involve symbolism inspired by ideas and themes inherent in the musical culture of the time The introduction describes the historical and theoretical premises of the use of the terms *allegory* *sign* and *symbol* and goes into the aspect of number symbolism as well as the aims limits and principles of *musico symbolical* analysis Other studies concentrate on Dufay and Josquin deal with the symbolical application of *soggetto ostinato* and canon technique or treat such themes as music for the dead and the Holy Virgin The final study is about the conception of heavenly music and musical composition *Symbolic Scores* is finely illustrated and includes musical examples and indices of compositions and names

Peasants Uprising 1381 the libretto play juxtaposes sacred and secular worlds the relative power and servitude of rulers and serfs and the terrifying ordeal of Christine who is caught between the inflexibility of the established church and her personal religious expectations Such a narrative was to offer rich opportunities for musical characterization and evocation of the historical context of the action as well as substantial challenges in pacing and integrating the sequence of dramatic snapshots that culminate in a scene of total despair The colourful juxtaposition of secular life and that of a recluse in Act One culminates in a Second Act finale of immense dramatic power in which Saxton's vocal and instrumental writing reaches new heights a landmark both in his output and in late 20th century opera Caritas first performed in 1991 occupies an important position in Robert Saxton's output and as Thomas argues in British opera during the closing decades of the 20th century Thomas provides a detailed contextual setting in which to evaluate Caritas as well as presenting an analytical commentary on the structure musical language instrumentation staging and production of the opera Thomas concludes with a reflection on the reception of Caritas as well as looking forward to Saxton's later and future works A CD of the first performance is included
