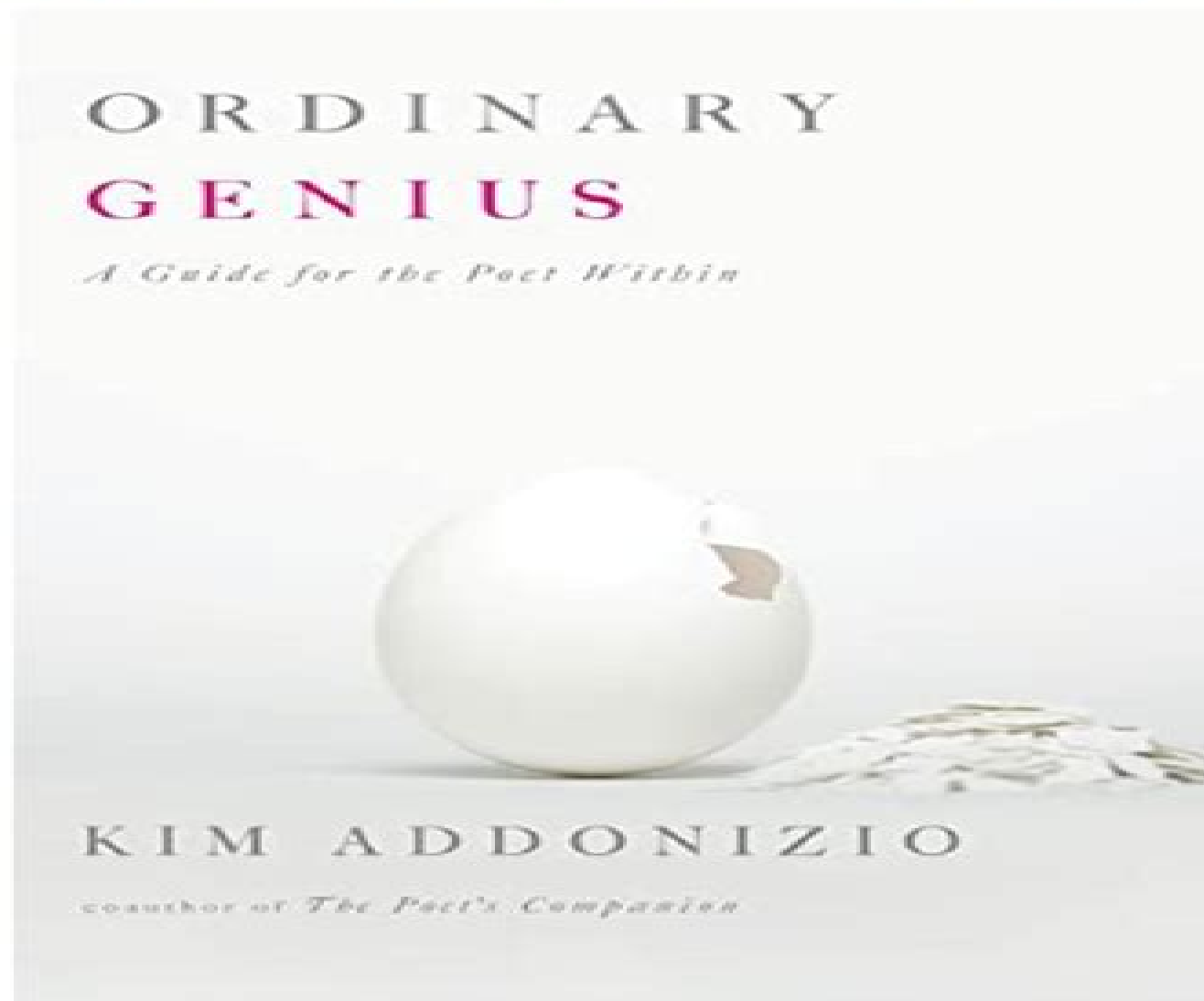

Wreathing Jed Rasula, 2022-03-29 Jed Rasula is a preeminent scholar of avant garde poetics noted for his erudition intellectual range and critical independence He is also a gifted writer his recent books have won praise for their entertaining clear prose in addition to their scholarship He is also an alumnus of UAP's distinguished Modern and Contemporary Poetics series which published his *Syncopations* fifteen years ago Rasula returns to the MCP series with *Wreathing* A collection of essays interviews and occasional writings that reflects the breadth and diversity of his curiosity One of the referees likened *Wreathing* to a victory lap but one that sets its own further record in the taking This is a collection of highlights from Rasula's shorter critical pieces but also a carefully assembled and revised intellectual autobiography *Wreathing* consists of two parts an assortment of Rasula's solo criticism and selected interviews and conversations with other critics and scholars Evelyn Reilly Leonard Schwartz Tony Tost Mike Chasar Joel Bettridge and Ming Qian Ma The collection opens with a trio of essays that complicate the idea of a poet By interrogating the selection of poets for anthologies in the 20th century Rasula identifies a host of forgotten poets once prominent but now forgotten Another essay on the state of the poetry anthology reveals how much influence literary gatekeepers have and what a reimagining of the anthology form could make possible In subsequent chapters Rasula finds surprising overlap between Dada and Ralph Waldo Emerson charts the deep links between image and poetic inspiration and reckons with Ron Silliman's *The Alphabet* a UAP classic In the book's second half Rasula engages in detailed conversations with a roster of fellow critics Their exchanges confront ecopoetics the corporate university the sheer volume of contemporary poetry and more This substantial set of dialogues gives readers a glimpse inside a master critic's deeply informed critical practice and lists his intellectual touchstones The balance between essay and interview achieves a distillation of Rasula's long established idea of *wreathing* In his original use the term denotes how any act of criticism inherently adds to the body of writing that it purports to read how Rasula couldn't help but participate in his favorite poems In this latest form *Wreathing* captures a critical perception that sparks insight and imagination no matter what it sees

Learning the Secrets of English Verse David J. Rothman, Susan Delaney Spear, 2022-08-09 This textbook teaches the

writing of poetry by examining all the major verse forms and repeating stanza forms in English. It provides students with the tools to compose successful lines of poetry and focuses on meter including free verse, rhythm, rhyme, and the many other tools a poet needs to create both music and meaningfulness in an artful poem. Presenting copious examples from strong poets of the past and present along with many recent student examples, all of which are scanned, each chapter offers lessons in poetic history and the practice of writing verse along with giving students a structured opportunity to experiment writing in all the forms discussed. In Part 1, Rothman and Spear begin at the beginning with Anglo-Saxon Strong Stress Alliterative Meter and examine every major meter in English up to and including the free verse forms of modern and contemporary poetry. Part 2 presents a close examination of stanza forms that moves from the simple to the complex, beginning with couplets and ending with the 14-line Eugene Onegin stanza. The goal of the book is to give students the essential skills to understand how any line of poetry in English may have been composed, the better to enjoy them and then also write their own: the keys to the treasure chest. Rothman and Spear present a rigorous curriculum that teaches the craft of poetry through a systematic examination and practice of the major English meters and verse forms. Under their guidance, students hone their craft while studying the rich traditions and innovations of poets writing in English. Suitable for high school students and beyond, I studied with Rothman in graduate school and went through this course with additional scholarly material.
