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Sir Henry Wrenfordsley John Michael Bennett, 2004 Of all Chief Justices in Australia in the 19th century none so demeaned the office as did Sir Henry Wrenfordsley second Chief Justice of Western Australia Moving from an indifferent practice as a Dublin solicitor to a very insecure career as an English barrister Wrenfordsley won notice for his interest in Conservative politics twice standing unsuccessfully for Parliament An able public speaker and a companionable guest at gentlemen s clubs he obtained a colonial judicial appointment through patronage He served in Mauritius before being appointed Chief Justice of Western Australia and then of Fiji He acted as a judge in Tasmania and Victoria and finally was Chief Justice of the Leeward Islands In every office he collided with colonial administrators and fellow lawyers and was in constant dispute with the Colonial Office A weak lawyer he was ridiculed as a journeyman judge and a gallery judge who turned the court into a theatre His public career was marked by every bad judicial quality incompetence duplicity interference in politics laziness uncontrollable temper chronic insolvency and overwhelming self importance among them The Western Australian State Set of Lives of Australian Chief Justices which includes Sir Archibald Burt Sir Henry Wrenfordsley and Sir Alexander Onslow is available for 130 00 to order the WA State Set click here [George Higinbotham](#) John Michael Bennett, 2006 George Higinbotham s extreme and uncompromising radical views and mesmerizing oratory have made him an iconic figure in Victoria s colonial history the darling of the liberals and the left John Bennett has written a major re assessment of this giant who was a dominating figure from the 1850s until his death in 1892 Higinbotham was successively a gold digger who found no gold a barrister who found few briefs a crusading editor of Melbourne s Argus an independent member of Parliament who opposed political parties and ferociously attacked the squatter dominated Legislative Council and the Colonial Office an overtly democratic Attorney General who advocated government without supply and Chief Justice of Victoria when his political dreams all foundered Yet he drew others to him as a Pied Piper He was a mass of contradictions Extraordinarily charitable to beggars he treated his family miserably A failure in achievement he retained an enormous popularity which has endured for over a century The Victorian State Set of Lives of Australian Chief Justices which includes Sir William a Beckett Sir William Stawell and George Higinbotham is available for 120 00 to order the Victorian State Set click here [Sir James Cockle](#) John Michael Bennett, 2003 James Cockle was a brilliant mathematician a future Fellow of the Royal Society appointed Chief Justice of Queensland in the most stormy and unpromising of circumstances When he came to Queensland in 1863 relations between the government and A J P Lutwyche the resident Supreme Court Judge were in a state of turmoil **Sir John Pedder** John Michael Bennett, 2003 John Pedder a shy ascetic gentlemanly personality was appointed first Chief Justice of Tasmania in 1823 Even he was surprised he had been only three years in practice Probably his loyalty to the Church of England appealed to the Colonial Office The new Chief Justice was shocked by the cost of living in the convict colony of Van Diemen s Land the reduced state of society and the harshness of the dominant penal system He was acutely

conscious of the finality of the death penalty and publicly protested the ill treatment of Tasmanian Aborigines In his very first trial the first held in any Australian Supreme Court a white man was convicted of the manslaughter of an Aboriginal Pedder was Sir Guy Green states in his foreword a competent and enlightened trial judge whose work had a great impact on the everyday life of the colony He was less successful when confronted by the novel and extremely difficult questions of public law which arose as the rule of law was established and challenged in the small and remote colony As an Executive Councillor he was notorious for diffident and ambivalent opinions Other criticism that he was a hectoring bully in court that he ducked and delayed decisions in the civil jurisdiction is shown to be false His 30 years on the Bench were remarkable for his industry and conscientiousness a most comprehensive and thorough account of Pedder s life and times which makes a significant contribution to the history of Tasmania and Australia generally Sir Guy Green The Tasmanian State Set of Lives of Australian Chief Justices which includes Sir John Pedder Sir Valentine Fleming and Sir Francis Villeneuve Smith is available for 130 00 to order the Tasmanian State Set click here

Sir William Stawell John Michael Bennett, 2004 As a judge and Chief Justice Stawell was ideal for his times In the later half of the nineteenth century Victoria needed a judge who was able to dispense justice speedily He was a man prepared to lead the community by speaking out in a variety of venues on the necessity of the rule of law the vital plank in an ordered society

Sir James Martin John Michael Bennett, 2005 Intelligence ambition and self belief took Martin the son of the Governor s Irish groom to the pinnacles of colonial law and politics He is the only man to have been both been Premier and Chief Justice of New South Wales He made his name as a fierce and partisan contributor to the vitriolic political debates of the 1840s A brilliant young lawyer he was in Parliament in 1848 before the age of 30 He stayed there in and out of government until 1873 when he made an honourable exit to the highest judicial office in the colony Knighthood and civil honours followed Self made rich arrogant and married to the wealthy daughter of a former convict Martin attracted enemies so that as Premier he could not always guarantee the passage of his legislation and at times lost his parliamentary seat Through all this he conducted a huge Bar practice and was appointed Chief Justice Remembered as a man springing from the people and educated amongst them he showed every quality which is necessary to a great and good Judge in a career of rare accomplishment The NSW State Set of Lives of Australian Chief Justices which includes Sir Francis Forbes Sir James Dowling Sir Alfred Stephen Sir James Martin and Sir Frederick Darley is available for 210 00 to order the NSW State Set click here

 John Michael Bennett,2002 Charles Cooper a timid retiring weak voiced sickly and barely successful English barrister
 accepted appointment as Judge in South Australia in 1839 A sound rather than a brilliant lawyer duty was his watchword
 evangelical churchmanship his consolation For 17 years he trudged on through illness and the meanness of the Colonial
 Office which saw him one of the worst paid judges on colonial service In 1856 he was recognized at last with appointment as
 the Province s first Chief Justice Dr Bennett shows that the appointment was well merited In a strong re evaluation Cooper is
 shown to have been a good and effective judge whose puny modern reputation has been shaped too much by the distorted
 politically based views of critics of his day His early years on the Bench required him to grapple with the problem of trying to
 apply English law to the indigenous people He brought peace to a querulous legal profession and did much to reverse
 entrenched community contempt for authority existing in Adelaide on his arrival His workload was enormous He remained
 the only judge until 1850 and thereafter he found himself often in collision with the eccentric and irrepressible Benjamin
 Boothby appointed puisne judge in 1853 Sick and exhausted Sir Charles Cooper retired to England on a pension in 1861
 There he regained his health and survived to the age of 92 a further 26 years He had supported the explorations of Charles
 Sturt who named the legendary Cooper s Creek in his honour **A Complete List of British and Colonial Law Reports**

and Legal Periodicals William Harold Maxwell,Charles Raynor Brown,1995 *Sir Archibald Burt* John Michael
 Bennett,2002 Archibald Paull Burt reputed to be the ablest lawyer in the West Indies arrived in Western Australia in 1861 at
 the age of 50 when bureaucratic disputes blocked his preferment in the Caribbean He advised the government on the need
 for a Supreme Court of comprehensive jurisdiction and helped to see into place that and many other legal and constitutional
 changes He was appointed first Cheif Justice of the colony and until his death in 1879 he was the Colony s sole judge

Children and Cross-Examination J R Spencer,Michael Lamb,2012-06-01 In 2009 Stephen Barker was convicted of rape on
 the evidence of a little girl who was four and a half years old at the trial and about three and a half when first interviewed by
 the police The high point of the proceedings was the child s appearance as a live witness in order for Barker s counsel to
 attempt a cross examination This case focused attention on the need imposed by current English law for even tiny children to
 come to court for a live cross examination In 1989 the Pigot Committee proposed a scheme under which the whole of a young
 child s evidence including cross examination would be obtained out of court and in advance of trial In 1999 a provision
 designed to give effect to this was included in the Youth Justice and Criminal Evidence Act but it has not yet been brought
 into force The full Pigot proposal was implemented however in Western Australia and similar schemes operate in a number of
