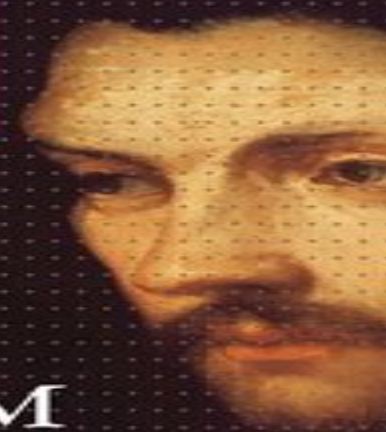

Notes From The House Of The Dead:

Reading Dostoevsky Victor Terras, 1998 Admirers have praised Fedor Dostoevsky as the Russian Shakespeare while his critics have slighted his novels as merely cheap amusements In this critical introduction to Dostoevsky's fiction the author asks readers to draw their own conclusions about the nineteenth century Russian writer Discussing psychological political mythical and philosophical approaches he guides readers through the range of diverse and even contradictory interpretations of Dostoevsky's rich novels

Redemption and the Merchant God Susan McReynolds Oddo, 2008 Dostoevsky's antisemitism manifested in his writings of the 1870s seems to contradict his humanism and many critics have tended to dismiss it as a marginal detail of the writer's views Argues however that antisemitism held an important place in Dostoevsky's ethical system and was linked to his vexed relationship with Christianity Notes that he staunchly held three ethical principles sanctity of children incompatibility of ethics with utilitarianism and calculation and the view that every kind of authority was bound by the same moral strictures as individuals Thus he could not accept a God who had sacrificed his son or a redemption brought about by the suffering of a child Jesus Dostoevsky invented the image of a Jew onto whom he could project everything that was unacceptable to him in religion and Western ethics He considered the merchant ethics of both liberalism and socialism to be a Jewish idea and in particular regarded the politics of the Jew Disraeli as an embodiment of such ethics to sacrifice innocent Balkan Slavs in the name of supreme political principles In the 1870s Dostoevsky increasingly contrasted the Russian conception of God and compassion for the weak with the Jewish Western merchant God and the idea of obtaining benefits for one person from the suffering of another innocent person He developed a conception of principal opposition between things Russian and things Jewish

Physical Pain and Justice Gary Rosenshield, 2017-10-04 It has been said that all great literature is about suffering But before the twentieth century physical pain one of the most primal forms of human suffering has rarely been represented on the stage and in fiction But when it is foregrounded in works of literature it is not only the most dramatic way of representing human suffering it is also used to explore in the most intense form existential questions regarding the meaning of human existence and the justice of the universe Perhaps it is not entirely coincidental then that imaginative works about physical pain though few in number figure prominently among the masterpieces of the western literary tradition The best were written during two of the west's most astonishing periods of literary creativity fifth century BC Athens and nineteenth century Russia and by the most prominent artists of their time Prometheus Bound by Aeschylus The Women of Trachis and Philoctetes by Sophocles Notes from the House of the Dead by Dostoevsky and The Death of Ivan Ilyich and War and Peace by Tolstoy In all these works physical pain is always portrayed as a dynamic process that includes the view point of the victim the perpetrator much of the physical pain is in the form of torture and the onlooker or witness In the Greek works physical pain is the main vehicle for exposing the injustice of the gods and the world order and in the Russian works for questioning the moral legitimacy of the state In Prometheus Bound Zeus

delegitimizes his rule by torturing Prometheus for his service to mankind In The Women of Trachis the gods look indifferently upon the excruciating suffering of Hercules the greatest Greek hero In Philoctetes the gods cruelly exploit the terrible pain of the hero as a means of winning victory at Troy for their Greek wards In the Russian works the mechanisms for inflicting the maximum amount of physical pain during corporal punishment undermine the moral foundations of the state and argue for its dissolution Though the Greek and Russian works are separated by genre plays vs novels and by time over two thousand years they are united by the way they employ pain to investigate the justice or rather injustice of the world order Worlds Apart Benjamin Paloff,2025-04-29 A number of European authors who survived concentration camps ghettos and besieged cities in the middle of the twentieth century chose not to write straightforward memoirs or testimonials but instead to fictionalize their experiences By manipulating narrative time and point of view and altering biographical facts these writers produced literary texts that challenge common notions of what constitutes an appropriate representation of collective trauma How might such works provide a deeper understanding of historical truth than the facts alone What does the literature of the camps reveal about present day spaces of confinement Worlds Apart explores the ethics of representation by reading the works of writers who use the techniques of literary fiction to depict survival in these precarious spaces Benjamin Paloff traces the complex relationship between fact and truth in these texts disentangling writers individual experiences from fictional elements that universalize that experience and in so doing show the camp to be an institution of the present Touring the unusual genre conventions of these works he weighs crucial questions about what constitutes truth in historical representation literature and the popular imagination Reading across Czech French German Polish Russian and Yiddish including lesser known and untranslated works Paloff considers portrayals of the Shoah the Gulag the Warsaw Ghetto Uprising and the blockade of Leningrad Bold nuanced and rich in comparative insight Worlds Apart argues forcefully for the moral urgency of recognizing that the camp is not simply a historical artifact but a basic institution of contemporary society

The House of the Dead Fyodor Dostoyevsky,2004-02-05 In January 1850 Dostoyevsky was sent to a remote Siberian prison camp for his part in a political conspiracy The four years he spent there startlingly re created in The House of the Dead were the most agonizing of his life In this fictionalized account he recounts his soul destroying incarceration through the cool detached tones of his narrator Aleksandr Petrovich Goryanchikov the daily battle for survival the wooden plank beds the cabbage soup swimming with cockroaches his strange family of boastful ugly cruel convicts Yet The House of the Dead is far more than a work of documentary realism it is also a powerful novel of redemption describing one man s spiritual and moral death and the miracle of his gradual reawakening **Notes from a Dead House** Fyodor Dostoevsky,2015-03-24 From the acclaimed translators Richard Pevear and Larissa Volokhonsky comes a new translation of the first great prison memoir Fyodor Dostoevsky s fictionalized account of his life changing penal servitude in Siberia In 1849 Dostoevsky was sentenced to four years at hard labor in a Siberian prison camp for his participation in a utopian socialist discussion group

The account he wrote after his release based on notes he smuggled out was the first book to reveal life inside the Russian penal system. The book not only brought him fame but also founded the tradition of Russian prison writing. *Notes from a Dead House* sometimes translated as *The House of the Dead* is filled with vivid details of brutal punishments, shocking conditions, feuds and betrayals, and the psychological effects of the loss of freedom, but it also describes moments of comedy and acts of kindness. There are grotesque bathhouse and hospital scenes that seem to have come straight from Dante's *Inferno*, alongside daring escape attempts, doomed acts of defiance, and a theatrical Christmas celebration that draws the entire community together in a temporary suspension of their grim reality. To get past government censors, Dostoevsky made his narrator a common law criminal rather than a political prisoner, but the perspective is unmistakably his own. His incarceration was a transformative experience that nourished all his later works, particularly *Crime and Punishment*. Dostoevsky's narrator discovers that even among the most debased criminals, there are strong and beautiful souls. His story reveals the prison as a tragedy both for the inmates and for Russia; it is finally a profound meditation on freedom. The prisoner himself knows that he is a prisoner, but no brands, no fetters will make him forget that he is a human being.
