Subject: Mathematics

Objectives:

Using number talks children will be:

- (i) Confident in solving math problems.
- (ii) Gradually speed up in calculations.
- (iii) Be more flexible to reach mathematical solution

Lesson Plan:

Number talk is nothing but discussions over numbers. It helps children to grow confident with numbers and not feel anxious. It helps them to think, visualize, be flexible in using mathematical strategies and reach the end result of a problem via multiple ways rather one!

Exposing children to this earlier in life helps them to become more comfortable and have fun with numbers rather than feeling all confused. They also feel encouraged to justify and explain their stance on how they got to the end result.

The best part of number talks or math chats is that it does not have to be structured! For a beginner, start with basic conversations or discussions. for example, ask a child "If I add 5 and 7, what will be the total of it? the child will say the answer 12.

Now, ask them is there any other way we can get the answer 12, by adding, subtracting any other two numbers? (they may answer: 6+6; 3+9; 15-3, and so on.) Help them by giving examples if they are unable to.

Alright after leading the conversation in this direction, we move forward to some of the techniques that can be used:
