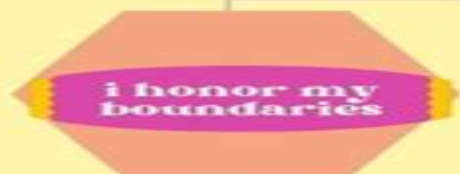


Practice Mindfulness
