## What is customer service?

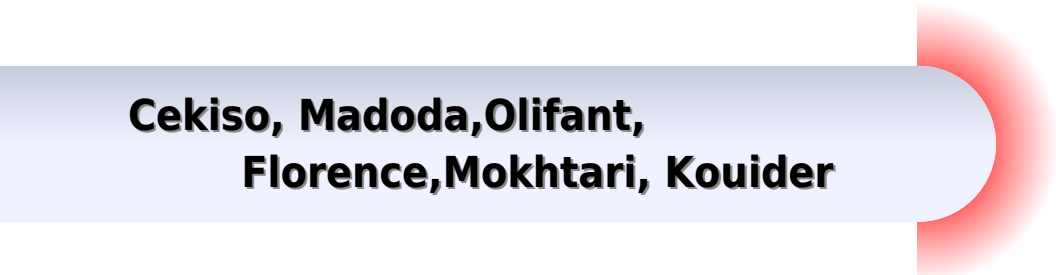
