cloud that follows me throughout most of this autobiography I wasnt able to attend college fulltime until I finished my 20 years in the U S Navy Then finishing With Honors gave my mother extreme pride after her total education was a small 12 total students high school in sticks of Mississippi I had almost completed by Masters Degree and CA Lifetime Teachers Credential when I got into Major League Baseball and went to Chicago Robert B.
