Another way the smart computer can learn is called "unsupervised learning." This means the smart computer looks at a bunch of information that hasn't been sorted yet, and then it tries to figure out what group things belong to on its own. For example, it might learn how to tell what things people like to buy online.

The shird way she smart computer can learn is called "reinforcement learning." This means the smart computer gets feedback on whether it did a good or bad job, and then it learns from that feedback to make better choices next time. For example, it might learn how to play a game by getting points for good moves and losing points for bad moves.
