TikTok



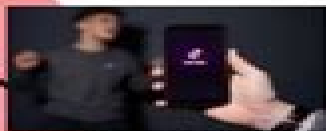
It's been a while since a new social app got big enough, to make non-users feel they're missing out from experience.

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Living with Algorithms Ignacio Siles, 2023-04-25 A nuanced account from a user perspective of what it's like to live in a datafied world. We live in a media saturated society that increasingly transforms our experiences, relations and identities into data others can analyze and monetize. Algorithms are key to this process, surveilling our most mundane practices and to many their control over our lives seems absolute. In *Living with Algorithms* Ignacio Siles critically challenges this view by surveying user dynamics in the global south across three algorithmic platforms: Netflix, Spotify and TikTok, and finds surprisingly a more balanced relationship. Drawing on a wealth of empirical evidence that privileges the user over the corporate, Siles examines the personal relationships that have formed between users and algorithms as Latin Americans have integrated these systems into the structures of everyday life: enacted them, ritually participated in public with and through them, and thwarted them. Sometimes users follow algorithms, Siles finds, and sometimes users resist them. At times users do both. Agency lies in the navigation of the spaces in between. By analyzing what we do with algorithms rather than what algorithms do to us, *Living with Algorithms* clarifies the debate over the future of datafication and whether we have a say in its development.
