Phenomenology of Life and the Human Creative Condition Anna-Teresa Tymieniecka, 1997-12-31 Self-individualization has been interpreted as the process in which the all-embracing Self unfolds into an infinite variety of different individuals plants animals and men A comparison of the different ways in which the Self manifests itself in the biological and psychological developmental processes or in a visionary image of the undivided Self reveals the same basic structure of expression The Self the one is represented by a circular domain and comprises a basic inner duality the two creating a paradox of conflicting opposites In the undivided Self the two give rise to a trinity in which however a quaternity is hidden The latter expresses itself in this world as the four basic forces the four Elements or the four main archetypes specifying the possibilities or development in space and time Self-individualization starts with the first appearance of a primary structure of an individual sub-Self This is the fifth basic force the fifth Element Further development is characterized by four generative principles 1st the principle of wholeness connection and integration being oriented to remaining whole or restoring wholeness 2nd the principle of complementarity and compensation a periodic shift between opposing

influences 3rd the enstructuring principle causing the relative stability of the spatial appearance of the manifest structure and 4th the principle of gesture resulting in a gradual stepwise development of that structure into a full grown individual

The Immanence of the Infinite Elizabeth Brient, 2002 Most scholars would agree that there is an epochal threshold between the world of the Middle Ages and the modern world Agreement on the nature and dynamic structure of that threshold is harder to come by Hans Blumenberg's original and compelling account of the transition from medieval to modern given in his 1966 work *The Legitimacy of the Modern Age* has received wide attention Elizabeth Brient begins her own account of the transition with an extensive critical assessment of central aspects of Blumenberg's work She elucidates his dialogical method of historical explanation then discusses the shortcomings of his defense of the legitimacy of modernity The transition to the modern world is marked by the process of making infinite the finite medieval cosmos Whereas Blumenberg focused on the spatial infinitization of the universe Brient claims that the process must be understood intensively as well as extensively In the now infinite universe of the new science the problem of finding a measure for man's self assertive activity and for human knowledge comes to the fore The second half of the book focuses on the way in which this difficulty is addressed with conceptual resources developed in the tradition of late medieval Neoplatonism in particular in the speculative thought of Meister Eckhart and Nicholas of Cusa Specific attention is given to the way in which Cusanus' notion of the immanence of the infinite in the finite responds to the need for a regulative ideal for human knowing This is the first book length treatment of Blumenberg to appear in English and will be a most welcome resource for readers engaged by debates concerning the status of modernity It will be of equal interest to students of Eckhart and Cusanus and to those generally concerned with the transition between the medieval and the modern world ABOUT THE AUTHOR Elizabeth Brient is Assistant Professor of philosophy at The University of Georgia PRAISE FOR THE BOOK Blumenberg could not have wished for a more reverent critique of his achievements or a more exacting textual exegesis regarding the sources of their philosophical content all written in a lucid style that is forthright in the defense of the depth of thought during the Middle Ages but also pleasing in its subtle irony with respect to Blumenberg's and the author's own metaphysical creed Walter F Veit *Speculum* Brient's analysis of Blumenberg's philosophy sheds significant light in the debate concerning modernity
